CODE REVISION NOTICE

Pursuant to Section 120J of the *Electricity Act 1994*, the Queensland Competition Authority (QCA) advises that revisions to the Electricity Industry Code (the Code) were approved by the Minister for Energy and Water Supply. The changes:

- (a) escalate the current Guaranteed Service Level (GSL) payment amounts and annual payment cap (excluding GSLs for wrongful disconnections) applicable to Energex and Ergon Energy for the next regulatory period, commencing 1 July 2015, by 9.15%, to maintain their real deterrent value
- (b) amend the planned interruption GSL notification provisions for the next regulatory period, commencing 1 July 2015, contained under clause 2.5.8 of the Code. The amendments:
 - require a distribution entity to provide at least four business days' notice of a planned interruption to supply (except in the case of emergencies) to a small customer's premises
 - (ii) allow the notice period of a planned interruption to supply to a small customer's premises to be varied by agreement in writing between the distribution entity and the small customer. The agreement must:
 - state the new period in which the distribution entity must notify the affected small customer of a planned interruption
 - include a statement stating that the small customer provides explicit informed consent to enter into the agreement
 - notify the small customer of their right to at least four business days' notice of a planned interruption to supply to the customer's premises if the period is not varied
 - state that the small customer may be eligible for a GSL payment if the notice period is varied and the small customer does not agree to the variation.

The revised Code (version 18) will come into effect on and from 1 July 2015.
