**ADOPTION OF A TEMPORARY LOCAL PLANNING INSTRUMENT
OVERRIDING MAROOCHY PLAN 2000**

Notice is given under the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*, Section 117 that on 10 January 2014 the Sunshine Coast Regional Council adopted:

Temporary Local Planning Instrument 01/2014 (Sippy Downs Town Centre) overriding *Maroochy Plan 2000*.

The temporary local planning instrument will have effect on and from 13 January 2014.

The purpose and general effect of the temporary local planning instrument is to expedite the planning and delivery of the Sippy Downs Town Centre, including the Business and Technology Park and stimulate economic development and jobs growth on the Sunshine Coast.

The temporary local planning instrument suspends the operation of provisions of *Maroochy Plan 2000* in respect to the Sippy Downs Town Centre and applies new provisions affecting the operation of *Maroochy Plan 2000* in respect to Sippy Downs Town Centre by:

- providing revised development assessment tables for material change of use, reconfiguring a lot and special management areas in Volume 1;
- making one amendment to the Strategic Plan in Volume 2;
- making five amendments to the Statement of Desired Character for Planning Area No. 3 (Sippy Downs); and
- providing a revised Code for Development in the Sippy Downs Town Centre.

The temporary local planning instrument will cease to have effect either on 13 January 2015 or the day after the Sunshine Coast Planning Scheme takes effect, whichever occurs earlier.

Minister Assisting the Premier Directive: Progression Arrangements for Department of Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services Frontline Child Safety and/or Adoption Services Employees

1. Purpose:

To declare progression arrangements for specified employees of the Department of Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services to facilitate the retention of skilled staff.

2. Effective date:

17 January 2014

3. Legislative provisions:

Sections 52(3) and 54(1) of the *Public Service Act 2008* (PSA).

4. Application:

This directive applies to the following public service officers and temporary employees engaged under section 148(2)(a) of the PSA in the Department of Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services (DCCSDS):

- employees with the job title of Child Safety Officer or Adoption Officer; or
- any other Level 2 employees employed in the professional stream identified by the chief executive of DCCSDS as performing 'frontline work'; and
- who are Level 2 employees employed in the professional stream in receipt of wages from paypoint 4 up to and including paypoint 6.

DIRECTIVE

5. Requirements for Progression:

5.1 Eligible employees are entitled to apply for progression to Level 3 of the professional stream.

5.2 The progression of an employee to Level 3 is subject to the employee satisfying progression criteria as detailed in clauses 5.10.2(a)-(d) of the *Queensland Public Service Award – State 2012* as well as fulfilling:

- a) the agency's skills passport requirements; and
- b) the relevant competencies of the role.

*Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act 1994***NOTIFICATION OF DANGER TO MARINE SAFETY**Maritime Safety Queensland
Brisbane 14 January 2014

I, James Huggett, Acting General Manager, Maritime Safety Queensland, pursuant to the provisions of sections 221(2) and (4) of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2004*, state that the operating of a ship or type of ship that is a modified personal watercraft connected to a device as defined below or that a person conducting an activity involving the operation of the device, endangers marine safety, unless:

- (i) the ship and/or the device is operated in the waters set out in Schedule A, and
- (ii) the ship and/or the device is operated in accordance with the conditions set out in Schedule B.

However, specific conditions in Schedule B do not apply to events or demonstrations approved by Maritime Safety Queensland, provided the conditions in Schedule C are complied with.

Note: Where the combined ship and device is considered a domestic commercial vessel under the *Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law Act 2012* (Cth), any requirements under the *Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law Act 2012* (Cth) shall prevail to the extent of any inconsistencies with the conditions under this gazette notice.

In this notice, the following definitions apply:

- (i) the device means either the airborne jetpack harness capable of being propelled in the air at the surface of the water and/or underwater that is connected via a water hose to an engine driven water jet floating pump or the airborne jetpack harness capable of being propelled in the air at the surface of the water and/or underwater that is connected via a water hose to a modified personal watercraft;¹
- (ii) the device user means the person in the airborne jetpack harness being propelled in the air at the surface of the water and/or underwater while connected to either an engine driven water jet floating pump or modified personal watercraft;
- (iii) personal watercraft means a powered ship that has a fully enclosed hull that does not take on water if capsized; and is designed to be operated by a person standing, crouching or kneeling on it or sitting astride it, rather than within the confines of it;
- (iv) personal watercraft operator means the person who is the master or has command or charge of the personal watercraft;
- (v) smooth waters means the waters— (a) of rivers, creeks, streams and lakes; or (b) within breakwaters or revetments; or (c) described in schedule 12 of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2004* that are within 0.5n mile from land; or (d) described in schedule 13 of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2004*;
- (vi) partially smooth waters – means the waters described in schedule 12 of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2004*, other than waters within 0.5n mile from land.

SCHEDULE A: Waters

**Smooth Waters; or
Partially Smooth Waters when the significant wave height does not exceed 0.5m from trough to crest; or
As authorised under a personal watercraft's condition of Queensland registration or national certification.**

SCHEDULE B: General Operating Conditions

- a) The device must only carry the number of persons the device is designed to carry;
- b) the device user must not operate the device alone;
 - (i) when the device is being operated connected to a modified personal watercraft, an appropriately licensed personal watercraft operator is required as an observer on the personal watercraft at all times;
 - (ii) when a personal watercraft is not being used, another ship is required;
 - (A) when the device is being controlled by the device user, with an observer on board to monitor the device operations;
 - (B) when the device is being remotely controlled from land, with the controller as observer on land or on board to monitor the device operations;
- c) the personal watercraft operator must hold an appropriate marine licence(s) and must have the kill switch safety lanyard attached to the personal watercraft operator's body;
- d) the personal watercraft must be appropriately registered or certified for operation in Queensland waters;
- e) the device must not be operated within 60 metres of any person or any other ship in the specified waters;
- f) the personal watercraft operator must make sure the area where the device will be used is clear of any other watercraft such as boats, other personal watercraft or other similar devices as well as swimmers, divers and other users in the specified waters;
- g) the device must be operated in sufficient water depths (4 metre minimum) in the place of operation before the device rises higher than 2 metres or starts diving;
- h) the personal watercraft operator must ensure that there is sufficient depth of water (4 metre minimum) in the place of operation before the device rises higher than 2 metres or starts diving;
- i) the device must not be operated within 60 metres of any source of risk such as rocks, docks etc, when rising higher than 5 metres or when diving;
- j) the device must not be operated when winds exceed 60 kilometres/hour or waves exceeding 1 metre in height;
- k) the device user must undergo training with an instructor appropriate to understand the basic safety and operational concepts;
- l) the device must be used in accordance with the manufacturer's safety recommendations;
- m) the device must be used in accordance with the applicable safety management plans, emergency response plans, risk management plans and other compliance documents;
- n) the general safety obligations, collision regulations and any other legislative requirements that apply to either a recreational or commercial personal watercraft or ship under the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act 1994* and *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2004* must be complied with.

SCHEDULE C: Special Event/Demonstration Operating Conditions**APPROVAL**

- a) The regional harbour master may direct or approve, for each of the following categories:
 - i) an owner, master and/or operator of a ship and/or device,
 - ii) an event or demonstration;
 - iii) a specified period of time,
 temporary non-compliance from one or more of the conditions specified in Schedule B (with the exception of section (n)), provided the following conditions are complied with:

¹ Examples of such devices include the Flyboard or Jetlev Flyer.

CONDITIONS

- b) The device to which a regional harbour master approval applies must only be operated by a qualified person appropriately skilled and appropriately trained to competently and safely perform specialised manoeuvres during the approved event/demonstration for the specified period in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations.
- c) An emergency service vehicle such as an ambulance must be on standby to take immediate and appropriate action in the event of an incident.
- d) Any other conditions a regional harbour master necessarily deems appropriate to ensure marine safety.
- e) The owner, master and/or operator of the ship and/or device to which a regional harbour master approval applies agree to indemnify and save harmless Maritime Safety Queensland from any claim, action, liability, loss, damage or suit arising from any damage, injury or harm suffered during the approved event/demonstration for the specified period, as a result of their non-compliance with the gazette conditions to which the approval applies, or non-compliance with any of the manufacturer's safety recommendations such as those specified in any operating manual regulating these devices.

This notice repeals the Notification of Danger to Marine Safety which was published in the Queensland Government Gazette No. 23 on 31 May 2013 in so far as it relates to these devices.
