Writ for Election

Elizabeth the Second, by the Grace of God, Queen of Australia and Her other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth

To the Electoral Commission of Queensland

Pursuant to s 83(1) of the Electoral Act 1992 I, Fiona Simpson MP, Speaker of the Legislative Assembly

- (i) direct that you proceed according to the law to an election of a Member of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland for the Electoral District of Redcliffe;
- (ii) appoint -

Tuesday, 28 January 2014 to be the day of issue of this Writ;

Monday, 3 February 2014 to be the cut-off day for electoral rolls for the election;

Thursday, 13 February 2014 to be the cut-off day for the nomination of candidates for the election;

Saturday, 22 February 2014 to be the polling day; and

Friday, 14 March 2014 for the return of this Writ.
