<p>Activity necessary for public health and safety or rehabilitation of the declared Fish Habitat Area (FHA) and supported by <i>Operational Policy Management: Management of declared Fish Habitat Areas</i>, or meets the requirements of the accepted development requirements for operational work that is completely or partly within a declared Fish Habitat Area. For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – new runnelling works by local government for insect pest control; or – restoration of fish habitats or natural processes (e.g. re-profiling and revegetation of a disturbed site). 	1
<p>Area of impact is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – a footprint of 50 square metres or less for a new structure; or – maintenance of an existing facility, where the temporary disturbance footprint is less than 50 square metres larger than the disturbance area allowed in accepted development requirements for operational work that is completely or partly within a declared Fish Habitat Area. 	2
<p>Area of impact is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – 50 square metre – 500 square metre footprint where natural bed or bank profiles would be altered (e.g. dredging, beach nourishment, bank revetment, boat ramp) or involve discharge of water (e.g. stormwater outlet, sewerage outlet); or – 50 square metre – 1000 square metre footprint where proposed activities will not alter natural bed or bank profiles or involve discharge of water (e.g. larger jetties and pontoons, bridges, raised boardwalks etc); or – 50 square metre – 1000 square metre footprint for maintenance of an existing facility, where the temporary disturbance footprint is larger than the disturbance area allowed in the accepted development requirements for operational work that is completely or partly within a declared Fish Habitat Area. 	3
