  c) acknowledge that this application is subject to any relevant policies (e.g. boat replacement, fishing history, etc), current at the time of this application being considered.
- d) acknowledge that if the second licence already has written on it a symbol of the same type as the symbol being moved, the pre-existing symbol on the second licence will be surrendered, leaving only one of that symbol written on the second licence except if the symbol being moved is a symbol which legislation states can be written on an authority multiple times, in which case the symbol will be written on the licence multiple times.

## Requirement checklist

To ensure your application to move a fishery symbol is not unduly delayed, please ensure the following requirements are satisfied:

Payment of application fee. Annual fees will also need to be paid up to date on the fishery symbols being moved.
 Written approval of each person, other than the licence holder, who has an interest in the licence noted in the Register of

## **Related applications** -

If the fishery symbol being moved is subject to quota, the holder of the second licence must ensure that they own or have usage of quota for the fishery prior to operating. This may mean that the second licence holder needs to lodge either of the following applications:

- Register Transfer of Quota Application (FDU1465)
- Register Temporary Transfer of Quota Application (FDU1469)

## Notes:

#### Witnesses to applicants signatures

- For individuals, signatures must be witnessed.
- For a corporation, the form is signed in accordance with the *Corporations Act 2001*, s127 by: either two directors, or a director and a company secretary, or the sole director who is the sole secretary.

It is recommended you seek independent financial advice before investing in commercial fisheries in Queensland.

#### Stamp Duty

**Queensland Stamp Duty** may be payable on the movement of a fishery symbol. Further details may be obtained from the Office of State Revenue on telephone (07) 3874 4088 (Brisbane area) or 1300 300 734 (outside Brisbane area). The Commissioner of Stamp Duties may take action against either the vendor or purchaser when recovering unpaid duty.

#### **Fishing History**

Applicants should be aware that a fishing history policy was introduced on 1 February 2010. Under that policy the second licence holder acquiring a fishery symbol/s will not also acquire the fishing history previously associated with the symbol/s. Once moved, the fishing history accumulated by the symbol/s, will remain with the first licence on which the symbol/s was attached
