



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Program highlights

In 2019–20 we completed:

- widening and sealing of a 6.1 kilometre section of the Barcaldine - Aramac Road
- pavement widening and strengthening works on the Landsborough Highway, between Dingo Creek and Darr River, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- pavement rehabilitation of various sections of Capricorn Highway between Alpha and Barcaldine
- pavement rehabilitation of various sections of Kennedy Developmental Road between Hughenden and Winton
- paving and sealing of a 3.8 kilometre section of Eyre
 Developmental Road between Bedourie and Birdsville
- pavement widening and rehabilitation of various sections of Kennedy Developmental Road, between Winton and Boulia, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.

In 2020-21 we will:

- complete pavement widening of 5.4 kilometres of Kennedy Developmental Road, between Winton and Boulia, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- complete paving and sealing on a section of Richmond - Winton Road
- complete paving and sealing of additional sections of Boulia - Tobermorey Road (Donohue Highway), jointly funded by the Australian Government, Queensland Government and Boulia Shire Council

- complete pavement widening of around 2 kilometres on Diamantina Developmental Road, between Boulia and Dajarra, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- complete works to improve flood resilience across the Georgina River floodplain on the Diamantina Developmental Road between Bedourie and Boulia
- complete pavement rehabilitation works on Barcaldine - Aramac Road
- commence pavement rehabilitation of sections of Blackall - Isisford Road
- commence paving and sealing of 2.5 kilometres of Alpha - Tambo Road
- commence paving and sealing of 7.9 kilometres of Diamantina Developmental Road between Windorah and Bedourie
- replace the timber bridge across the Barcoo River on the Dawson Developmental Road (Springsure – Tambo), jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- commence pavement strengthening and widening of the Capricorn Highway (Emerald – Alpha), as part of the Queensland Government's COVID-19 economic recovery response
- commence paving and sealing of sections of the Eyre Developmental Road (Bedourie – Birdsville), jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government as part of the COVID-19 economic recovery response

- commence paving and sealing of sections of the Cramsie Muttaburra Road, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government as part of the COVID-19 economic recovery response
- commence paving and sealing of a section of the Blackall - Jericho Road, as part of the Queensland Government's COVID-19 economic recovery response
- commence paving and sealing 5.3 kilometres of Birdsville Developmental Road (Morney – Birdsville), jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government as part of the COVID-19 economic recovery response
- commence progressive sealing of 4.6 kilometres of the Clermont - Alpha Road, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government as part of the COVID-19 economic recovery response.



Future plans

We continue to plan for the future transport requirements of Central West.

In 2020–21 key planning includes:

- commence planning activities for a heavy vehicle breakdown pad at Alpha
- continue to develop a business case for the continued paving and sealing of Blackall - Jericho Road
- prepare a business case for the continued paving and sealing of Eyre Developmental Road between Bedourie and Birdsville.
