Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 14 May 2025

Area: Southport pilotage area
Locality: South Wavebreak Island and 'Keyhole'
Activity: Dredge works and sand replenishment operations – various locations

Mariners are advised that:

Dredge works in South Wavebreak Island Channel will now include dredging the 'Keyhole' on the Southwestern corner of Wavebreak Island. Existing pipeline arrangements remain the same, with floating pipe infrastructure lit by flashing yellow lights.

Works will involve the cutter dredge NU ENTERPRISE Monday to Saturday between 0700 hours and 1800 hours. Works are expected to be completed by 30 June 2025.

The vessels will display appropriate day shapes and lights at night for safe passing sides.

Work vessels can be contacted on VHF channel 73 and VHF channel 16.

Mariners should navigate with caution, maintain a safe distance off and operate at reduced speed with minimal wash in the vicinity of these works.

Latitude and longitude positions are on WGS84 horizontal datum and are compatible with GDA2020 datum.
