

TAKING OF EASEMENT NOTICE (No. 3462) 2021

Short title

1. This notice may be cited as the Taking of Easement Notice (No. 3462) 2021.

Easement to be taken [s.9(6) of the Acquisition of Land Act 1967]

2. Easement is taken over land described in the Schedule 2 by the Chief Executive, Department of Transport and Main Roads, as constructing authority for the State of Queensland, for a purpose incidental to the purpose of transport (public marine transport infrastructure), in particular, access easement purposes and vests in the Chief Executive, Department of Transport and Main Roads, as constructing authority for the State of Queensland.

Terms and Conditions of Easement

3. The terms and conditions of the easement are set out in schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1

Terms of Easement

The following rights and obligations shall apply and be imposed by the proposed Easement for Access over the land described in the schedule.

1. Definitions

- 1.1 In this Easement unless the context or subject matter require otherwise:
 - (a) Breakwater means the man-made rock wall barrier constructed on the Easement Area.
 - (b) **Easement** means the rights and obligations in relation to the Easement Area set out in this Schedule.
 - (c) Easement Area means that part of the land (and any Improvements located on that land) described in this notice as the land taken.
 - (d) **Improvements** means any building, structure, fence, or other thing erected, installed or constructed on the Easement Area before the date of this Easement and includes the Breakwater.
 - (e) **Law** includes the provision of any statute, rule, regulation, proclamation, ordinance or by-law, present or future, whether State, Federal, local or otherwise.

- (f) Maintenance Works means any works necessary (including but not limited to repair or renewal) to ensure the Breakwater is at all times functioning effectively and includes a regular assessment and maintenance program.
- (g) **Owner** means any person who has an estate, interest, right, power or privilege in, over, or in relation to the Owner's Land and that person's administrators, assignees and successors.
- (h) **Owner's Land** means the whole of the land described in this notice as the land out of which the Easement Area has been taken.
- (i) Parties means collectively the Owner and the State and Party means one of them.
- (j) **Permitted Purpose** means pedestrian and vehicular access and undertaking Maintenance Works.
- (k) **RPEQ** means Registered Professional Engineer Queensland.
- (I) **Significant Maintenance Works** means any substantial Maintenance Works required as a result of atypical events (for example, breakdown of armour rock or large cyclonic events) causing significant damage to the Breakwater.
- (m) State means the State of Queensland (represented by Department of Transport and Main Roads) and its successors and assigns.
- (n) State's Agents includes the employees, agents, licensees, invitees, contractors and sub-contractors of the State and anyone authorised by the State.

2. Interpretation

- 2.1 In this Easement:
 - (a) headings are for convenience only and do not affect interpretation;
 - (b) the words include, including, such as, for example, and similar expressions are not words of limitation;
 - (c) a reference to an obligation or right of any two or more parties imposes that obligation or confers that right on each of them, as the case may be, jointly and severally;
 - (d) this Easement does not affect the power of the State as a Government body; and
 - (e) a reference to:
 - this or any other document includes the document as varied, novated, ratified or replaced and despite any change in the identity of the parties and includes all schedules, annexures, parts, exhibits and attachments to it;
 - (ii) a person includes a natural person, partnership, joint venture, unincorporated association, corporation and a Government body or other entity;
 - a party in this Easement includes the party's executors, administrators, successors, substitutes (including a party who becomes a party by novation), permitted assigns and in the case of a trustee, includes a substituted or an additional trustee;
 - (iv) the singular includes the plural and the plural includes the singular;
 - (v) any statute, ordinance, code or other law includes regulations and other instruments under any of them and consolidations, amendments, re-enactments or replacements of any of them;
 - (vi) an obligation includes a warranty or representation and a reference to a failure to comply with an obligation includes a breach of warranty or representation; and
 - (vii) a right includes a benefit, remedy, discretion or power.

3. Acquisition of Easement

3.1 The Chief Executive, on behalf of the State, is acquiring this Easement in perpetuity to permit the State and the State's Agents the full and free right and liberty at all times, to enter upon the Easement Area for the Permitted Purpose.

Without affecting the generality of the foregoing, in exercising its rights to enter the Easement Area, the State and State's Agents will have the right to:

- (a) construct, maintain, repair or renew on the Easement Area such access tracks, gates and appurtenant works as it considers necessary;
- (b) enter upon and remain, pass and repass on and over the Easement Area for all or any of the purposes aforesaid with or without vehicles, plant and equipment of any description whatsoever; and
- (c) enter upon and remain, pass and repass to and from the Easement Area over such part or parts of the Owner's land adjoining or adjacent to the Easement Area as is reasonably required by the State for undertaking the Permitted Purpose.
- 3.2 In addition:
 - (a) the State may, at any time, construct a breakwater structure on land adjoining the Easement Area that will abut and/or join the Breakwater in certain places (State's Structure); and
 - (b) the State will have the right to construct, access and maintain the State's Structure at any time and in any manner it considers necessary (including via the Easement Area).

4. State's Rights and Obligations

- 4.1 In exercising its rights under this Easement, the State must:
 - (a) comply with all relevant Laws;
 - (b) not wilfully damage or destroy any Improvement to any extent greater than is reasonably necessary in order to exercise its rights under this Easement.
 - (c) use reasonable endeavours to cause as little interference or disturbance to the Owner as reasonably practicable; and
 - (d) upon becoming aware of any damage to the Easement Area or any Improvement or any hazard or risk, immediately notify the Owner and take reasonable steps to avoid any further damage to the Easement Area or Improvement.
- 4.2 Where the State requires access to the Easement Area with a vehicle, the State agrees as follows:
 - (a) subject to clause 4.2(b)(iii), the State will utilise only rubber tyred or tracked vehicles with 3 tonne GVM or less on the Breakwater;
 - (b) if the State intends to upgrade/repair the Breakwater on the Easement Area to facilitate the exercise of its rights under this Easement:
 - (i) the State will notify the Owner of the proposed upgrade/repair works;
 - (ii) the State will provide an RPEQ-certified design and supporting geotechnical assessment of the proposed works; and
 - (iii) once the works are completed, the upgraded access design capacity for vehicles will replace the restriction in clause 4.2(a) above.

5. Owner's Rights and Obligations

- 5.1 The Owner:
 - (a) will have the right to use the Easement Area for any lawful purpose not inconsistent with the use by the State under the terms of this Easement;
 - (b) must not:

- erect, construct, install or place any new Improvement on the Easement Area which interferes with the State's use of the Easement Area for the Permitted Purpose, without the State's written consent;
- (ii) interfere with or obstruct the State in the exercise or enjoyment of its rights and powers under this Easement; or
- (iii) alter or disturb or permit to be altered or disturbed the grades and contours of the Breakwater; and
- (c) upon becoming aware of any damage to the Easement Area or any Improvement or any hazard or risk, immediately notify the State and take reasonable steps to avoid any further damage to the Easement Area or Improvement.

6. Maintenance Obligations

- 6.1 The Owner must:
 - (a) pay for all local authority rates, all assessments and lawful charges in relation to the Owner's Land, including the Easement Area; and
 - (b) subject to clause 6.2, maintain the Owner's Land (including the sections of Breakwater outside the Easement Area) in good repair and condition and in a manner that safeguards the structural integrity of the Breakwater, including but not limited to repairing damage caused by natural events and deterioration.
- 6.2 Subject to clause 6.4, the State must:
 - (a) undertake Maintenance Works on the Easement Area;
 - (b) maintain and repair any part of the Breakwater constructed by the State that extends beyond the Easement Area; and
 - (c) repair any damage:
 - (i) to the section of Breakwater located on the Easement Area; and
 - to the section of Breakwater located outside the Easement Area to the extent the damage is caused or contributed to by the State or any of the State's Agents,

as soon as reasonably practicable following the State becoming aware of the damage.

- 6.3 The State's obligations under clause 6.2 will only take effect from the date that the State gives written notice to the Owner that it is commencing construction works on the land adjoining the Easement Area.
- 6.4 If the State reasonably considers that Significant Maintenance Works are required on the Easement Area, the relevant works will be undertaken by the State at its cost.

7. Insurance

7.1 Both Parties must obtain and maintain in force general public liability insurance covering legal liability to pay for personal injury, property damage and any other liability arising out of or in any way connected with the use or occupation of the Easement Area or any other right conferred upon the Party under this Easement, with a limit of liability not less than \$20,000,000 on a per occurrence basis.
