Mariners are advised that:

A temporary no anchorage zone is in place at Fisherman Beach, Great Keppel Island on Saturday, 24 May and Saturday, 31 May 2025 between the hours of 1200 and 2359 to allow for the safe passage of ferry operators arriving and departing Fisherman Beach during the Sunset Sessions Music Event.

Vessels must not anchor within the bounded positions beginning at the northern tip of The Spit at approximate position latitude 23°10.783'S, longitude 150°55.967'E, heading in a westerly direction to approximate position latitude 23°10.817'S, longitude 150°55.900'E, then extending south parallel to Fisherman Beach approximately 0.16Nm to approximate position latitude 23°10.867'S, longitude 150°56.050'E, then straight into the shore line to approximate position latitude 23°10.867'S, longitude 150°56.100'E.

Positions (23°10.817'S, 150°55.900'E) and (23°10.900'S, 150°56.050'E) will be marked by way of a yellow buoy and yellow light (FL4s).

The above co-ordinates and no anchorage zone are shown in red on attached map S11-726 prepared by Maritime Safety Queensland and held at the Maritime Safety Queensland Gladstone Office.

Vessels outside this designated no anchorage zone may be required to move in circumstances, at the direction of an authorised Shipping Inspector, where marine safety is a concern.
