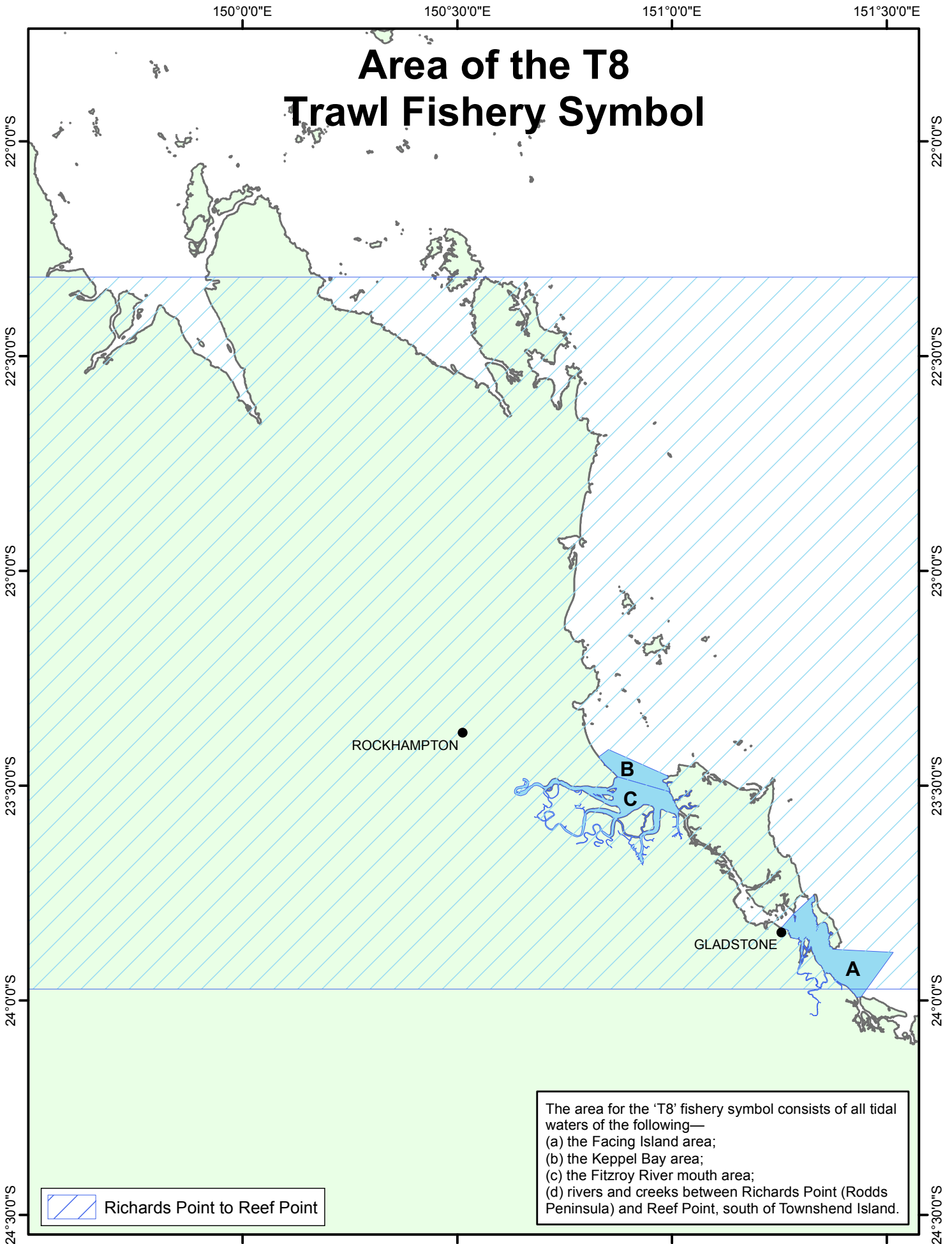


Area of the T8 Trawl Fishery Symbol



The area for the 'T8' fishery symbol consists of all tidal waters of the following—
 (a) the Facing Island area;
 (b) the Keppel Bay area;
 (c) the Fitzroy River mouth area;
 (d) rivers and creeks between Richards Point (Rodds Peninsula) and Reef Point, south of Townshend Island.
