NOTIFICATION OF DANGER TO MARINE SAFETY

Maritime Safety Queensland
Brisbane, 17 March 2018

I, Glenn N Hale, Regional Harbour Master, Maritime Safety Queensland, pursuant to section 197 (2) of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2016*, declare that a person must not anchor, berth, moor or operate a ship (other than a ship operated by those persons listed in Schedule B) in the waters described in Schedule A, for the period 12:00 pm Wednesday 4 April 2018 until 4:00pm Wednesday 4 April 2018 inclusive.

SCHEDULE A

All waters within 30 metres of vessels carrying the 2018 Commonwealth Games Queens Baton Relay between The Spit Gold Coast and Southport Yacht Club.

SCHEDULE B

- (a) Organizers of 2018 Commonwealth Games Queens Baton Relay;
- (b) Participants in the 2018 Commonwealth Games Queens Baton Relay;
- (c) Persons and vessels engaged as security, safety and officials for 2018 Commonwealth Games Queens Baton Relay;
- (d) Officers of Queensland Police Service;
- (e) Officers of Queensland Boating and Fisheries Patrol;
- (f) Officers of Maritime Safety Queensland; and
- (g) Officer of Gold Coast Waterways Authority.
