TEMPORARY FULL SUPPLY LEVEL (WIVENHOE DAM) DECLARATION NOTICE (No 1) 2022

Short title

1. This notice may be cited as the Temporary Full Supply Level (Wivenhoe Dam) Declaration Notice (No 1) 2022.

Notice of declaration [s.390 of the Act]

- The Minister considers the impacts of a potential flood or drought may be mitigated by having a full supply level for Wivenhoe Dam that is different from the full supply level stated in the resource operations licence for Wivenhoe Dam.
- Notice is hereby given that the Minister declares a temporary full supply level of E.L. 64.6 m A.H.D. for Wivenhoe Dam.
- In deciding whether to make a declaration of a temporary full supply level for Wivenhoe Dam, the Minister has had regard to:
 - (a) the consultation between the chief executive and the owner of the dam about the temporary full supply level; and
 - (b) the extent to which the temporary full supply level is likely to mitigate the impacts of a potential flood or drought; and
 - (c) the impacts the temporary full supply level may have on the water security of the dam; and
 - (d) whether the temporary full supply level would affect the safety of the dam; and
 - (e) other matters the Minister considers appropriate.
- This temporary full supply level declaration for Wivenhoe Dam:
 - (a) takes effect on 15 October 2022; and
 - (b) ceases to have effect on 28 February 2023 12 midnight.
