

Meeting Communique – 6 March 2025

The Queensland Energy System Advisory Board (the Board) held their fourth meeting online on 6 March 2025.

Queensland Treasury presented to the Board a range of insights from the initial energy system modelling that has been undertaken. The initial modelling has focused on understanding the potential pathways and impacts of different variables, and on delivering an affordable, reliable and sustainable Queensland electricity system. It is the first phase of detailed energy system modelling that Queensland Treasury is undertaking.

Queensland Treasury outlined the assumptions and variables tested in the initial modelling phase and sought Board feedback on the proposed assumptions for the next phase of modelling. It was agreed the assumptions would be shared for further out-of-session consideration and feedback.

The Board will meet in April to continue discussions on the modelling underway, including scenario development and final assumptions.

The Board agreed to further consider the amended Terms of Reference and Forward Work Program during the meeting to be held in April.
