Research Guide to Railway records at Queensland State Archives

Queensland State Archives (QSA) is the official repository for Queensland Government records selected for permanent retention because of their continuing value. The archived public records are from state government departments, state courts, local government authorities and statutory authorities. The records are in our facility at Runcorn, Brisbane, and open records are available for viewing in the Reading Room, free-of-charge.

QSA holds records about all aspects of government administration of railways constructed by, or for the Queensland Colonial and state governments. Information is mainly in the records of the Railway Department. The amount and type of information available on individual railways varies. Some files include plans and surveys of the railway, tender documents and correspondence about its construction and maintenance.

Unfortunately, important series of Commissioner for Railways, Chief Engineer's Branch, and the Chief Mechanical Engineer's Branch (or Locomotive Branch) prior to 1887 did not survive to be transferred to QSA, Runcorn. Some railway construction and railway operations records created before 1887 are in Lands and Works Department (1862-1866) and the Works Department (1866-1887) records. The Works Department records are mainly correspondence between the Commissioner and the Minister for Railways on policy about construction, changes in operations, and indents for rollingstock, rails and timber.

There is some information at QSA about private railways constructed by mining companies under specific enabling legislation, and later owned by the government, such as Chillagoe, Etheridge and Mount Molloy. There are private tramway records involving the government, for example, sale of rollingstock for use on tramways and drafting of legislation for the construction of private tramways.

The main finding aid for records held at QSA is the <u>Queensland State Archives' online catalogue</u> (known as ArchivesSearch).

The following citation abbreviations are used throughout our catalogue:

ITM QSA Item (describes the item)

PR Physical Representation (generally the original or microfilm copy)

DR Digital Representation (for a digital image)

S Series ID (for series of records)

A Agency ID (for the creating or responsible agency).

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander readers are advised that our catalogue contains images, names and voices of people who have died.

Queensland Rail Heritage Collection

The Queensland Rail Heritage Collection consists of 72 series of records transferred to Queensland State Archives from the Workshops Rail Museum, Ipswich, in 2019 and spans the years 1864 to 2007. In addition to the key series listed below, they also give us a glimpse into Queensland's past with railway brass bands, railway refreshment rooms and clock repair registers.

This heritage collection includes a series of glass plate and cellulose acetate negatives:

Railway Glass Plate Negatives

Digital copies of these glass plate negatives can be viewed online by following the series link to *Browse all items in series*. The negatives depict various subjects relating to rail travel and infrastructure and include

images of locomotives, carriages and wagons, stations, bridges and bridge construction, sections of track and special events. Negatives titled with 'E Series' are tourism and scenic images of Queensland. The glass plate negatives in this series have been carefully cleaned and restored by the Queensland State Archives Conservation team to allow them to be digitised.

To find all series of records in this heritage collection, search of our catalogue using title "Queensland Rail Heritage Collection". Each series has a Queensland Rail/Queensland Museum catalogue number. Refer to Appendix 1 of this research guide for catalogue numbers and corresponding QSA series citations.

To find general correspondence files, search Registers of Letters Received, <u>S10001</u>. The files are for business for which the administrative centre of the Railways Department was responsible.

This list is used to find records in Hard Batch Series, <u>\$9790</u>. Note: <u>\$6839</u> is incomplete.

Hard Batch Series 1/1/1867–31/12/1970

To find hard batch files, search List of Hard Batches, and Copies of All Indexes to Batches, <u>\$6839</u>. These finding aids are complemented by the *Guide to the hard batch series of correspondence 1867-1960* available on Reading Room computers under the *Finding Aids by QSA, Other* tile. These batches consist of bundles of correspondence files about particular subjects. These batches were grouped together for the convenience of the Railway Department. Examples of subjects include extension and construction of new railway lines, railway commissions and enquiries, accidents, strikes, Executive Council minutes, and the involvement of the railways in the First and Second World Wars.

These registers are used to find files numbers for General Correspondence, <u>S6873</u> and Hard Batches, <u>S9790</u>. These registers record general correspondence received, including for various Queensland lines.

Staff book entries may include name and date of birth of employee, dates of appointment, transfer or promotion, position, location or place of gang, remuneration, offences and remarks. Some volumes are arranged by branches, districts, areas of work, workshops, etc. Other volumes are alphabetical by employee.

Passed List Register

This register for the Roma district is a list of staff who passed Railway Department examinations.

Registers of Employment Applications

This series of registers is of individuals applying for positions in the Railway Department.

These registers are used to find Southern Division plans in <u>S4595</u> and <u>S17692</u>.

These indexes are used in conjunction with <u>S7698</u> to find Southern Division Plans in <u>S4595</u> and <u>S17692</u>.

Register of Central Division Plans

These registers are used to find Central Division plans in S4595 and S17692.

Register of Northern Division Plans

Circa 1/1/1908-31/12/1978 \$7700

These registers are used to find Northern Division plans in S4595 and S17692.

Plans and Sections of various Queensland Railway Lines (C22-C5475, N19-N4010, S66-S10977) Circa $\frac{1}{1}$ 865 – $\frac{31}{12}$ 1970

S4595

To find plans, search the registers, <u>Southern Division S7698</u>, <u>Central Division</u>, <u>S7699</u>, and <u>Northern Division</u>, <u>S7700</u>. These plans show the routes and grades taken by the railway lines, as well as surrounding topographical features and details of settlement and station yard plans.

Plans of Queensland Railway Station Buildings, Residences, Bridges and Station Equipment 1/1/1865 - 28/4/1999

S17692

To find plans, search the registers, <u>Southern Division S7698</u>, <u>Central Division, S7699</u>, and <u>Northern Division</u>, <u>S7700</u>. These are original drawings used for tender purposes and maintenance of, or alterations to, the original structures. They are scale drawings showing elevations and often the type of building materials used.

Original Trial Survey Registers

Circa 1/1/1870-21/12/1953 \$7696 These registers are used to find plans in S4593 and S4611.

Trial survey book of identification letters

Circa 1/1/ 1870-31/12/1953 \$7695

These survey books are used in conjunction with <u>\$7696</u> to find plans in <u>\$4593</u> and <u>\$4611</u>.

Plans and Sections of various Queensland Railway Lines (A535-Z529)

Circa 1/1/1865 – 31/12/1934

S4593

To find plans, search the registers, <u>S7696</u>. To search by specific alpha codes, search <u>ArchivesSearch</u> with the alpha code in the *Search for* field, and limit to <u>S4593</u>. These plans show routes and grades taken by the railway lines, surrounding topographical features and details of settlement, eg. main line to Toowoomba.

Plans and Sections of various Queensland Railway Lines (AA21-YB24)

Circa 1/1/1864 - 31/12/1983 S4611

To find plans, search the registers, <u>S7696</u>. These plans show routes and grades taken by the railway lines, surrounding topographical features and details of settlement, eg. Southern line to Stanthorpe and Wallangarra. To search by specific alpha codes, search <u>ArchivesSearch</u> with the alpha code in the *Search for* field, and limit to <u>S4611</u>. Examples of the rail line alpha codes are BCF – Bowen to Coalfields, AG – Atherton to Mt Garnet.

Plans of Queensland Railway Station Buildings, Residences, Bridges and Station Equipment (by code) 1/1/1866 – 31/12/1919 S17687

This series is plans of Queensland Railway station buildings, residences, bridges, livestock yards, turntables, footbridges, gates, grids, office furniture, tanks, boilers and pumps, wharves, gates for level crossings. In the Z - numbered plans there are some drawings of rollingstock and signalling equipment. The series is unindexed.

Railway Plans and Sections - Presented to Parliament

The plans and sections show routes and grades taken by the line. This series is unindexed.

This register is used to find general correspondence, \$6440

To find files, from 1886 to 1930, use Register – correspondence, <u>ITM275586</u>. Other years are unindexed. Files of the administration of the Branch, construction and repair of rollingstock (locomotives, rail motors, carriages and wagons), installation of machinery, and general staffing matters.

Numerical index to rollingstock drawings

Circa 1/1/1864-31/12/1955 ITM282292

This index of drawings is used to find drawings with the notation 'A' in <u>S17732</u>.

Railway Rollingstock Drawings

1/1/1867 – 31/12/1954 \$17732

To find drawings, use Index, ITM282292. This is the major series of rollingstock drawings with approximately 1,000 drawings mostly on tracing linen to ISO A0 size. Included are drawings of rollingstock supplied by contractors such as Charles Fox of London, as well as those constructed by Ipswich railway workshops. Includes coaching, goods and departmental stock such as 1st, 2nd class and composite passenger carriages, saloons and parlour cars, passenger and composite brake vans, Vice-Regal saloon, mortuary car, travelling post office, coal/ballast hoppers, etc. Also includes wagons - covered, open, refrigerated, livestock, elephant, fruit, tank, and timber. Drawings for each class of vehicle include brake gear, bogies or wheel sets, buffing and draw gear, underframes, bodies, carriage windows and doors, lighting, fittings and furnishings.

Numerical Index to Locomotive Drawings,

Circa 1/1/1890-31/12/1929 ITM292716

This index is used to find drawings of steam locomotives, \$17695.

Steam Locomotive Drawings

Circa 1/1/1864 – 31/12/1966 \$17695

To find drawings of steam locomotives, search the Numerical Index to Locomotive Drawings, <u>ITM292716</u>. Drawings are arranged alphabetically by the name of the locomotive.

Rail Motor Drawings

Circa 1/1/1916 – 31/12/1951 S17703

This series is of general arrangement drawings of rail motors and trailers. The series is unindexed.

Register of Rollingstock

Circa 1/1/1890 – 31/12/1915 ITM292715 in S9058

This register lists rollingstock (locomotives, wagons and carriages) operating on Queensland railways, including some wagons from 1864. It includes original rollingstock list for wagons with class, number,

description, dimensions of body/under frame, materials used in construction of rollingstock with remarks about write-off dates, details of modifications and transfers to other divisions. There are separate registers for Southern Division, 1890-1916, <u>S8839</u> and Central Division, 1890-1929, <u>S8840</u>.

Locomotive History Cards

1/1/1866 – 31/12/1969 <u>\$17520</u>

These cards provide information about alterations and repairs made to the locomotive, as well as engineering specifications. These cards are arranged in numerical order.

Steam Locomotive Boiler History Cards

1/1/1915 – 30/6/1969 \$17518

Arranged by locomotive number, cards record mileage by locomotives, boiler inspection and disposal details.

Rail Motor History Cards

1/1/1913 – 31/12/1971 S17523

Cards record manufacturing, alteration and repair details for rail motors.

Rail Motor Trailer History Cards

1/1/1918 – 31/12/1971 S17524

These cards list manufacturing details, repairs, alterations and dates condemned.
