- then to a point in the Maroochy River at latitude 26°38.404' south, longitude 153°04.687' east;
- then to a point in the Maroochy River at latitude 26°38.415' south, longitude 153°04.675' east;
- then generally westerly to a point in the Maroochy River at latitude 26°38.417' south, longitude 153°04.422' east;
- then to a point in the Maroochy River at latitude 26°38.407' south, longitude 153°04.410' east;
- then to a point in the vicinity of the outer extremity of the line of mangroves on the north side of the Maroochy River at approximate latitude 26°38.352' south, longitude 153°04.410' east; and
- then generally easterly along the outer extremity of the line of mangroves on the north side of the Maroochy River to the starting point.

  - (c) a ship operated by any of the following entities, if the ship is being operated in the course of the entity's activities –

- (i) a volunteer marine rescue association or an accredited surf lifesaving club;
- (ii) Queensland Fire and Emergency Services;
- (iii) Water Police, Queensland Police Service;
- (iv) Queensland Boating and Fisheries Patrol;
- (v) Maritime Safety Queensland.

At any time when there are 10 other nominated PWC being operated in the commercial PWC area by persons other than the provider – a nominated PWC operated by a person other than the provider.

**nominated PWC** means a personal watercraft that

- (a) is certified as a class 4 personal watercraft under the *Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law Act 2012* (Cwlth); and
- (b) displays a unique identifier as defined under that Act on both sides of the personal watercraft in characters at least 100mm high; and
- (c) is approved in writing by the Area Manager, North Brisbane/Sunshine Coast to operate in the area.

**provider** includes an employee of the provider.

**accredited surf life saving club** has the same meaning as in schedule 9 of the regulation.

- be operated in compliance with Marine Order 504 (Certificates of operation and operation requirements – national law) 2018 and the safety management system, as required under the *Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law Act 2012* (Cwlth).
- be operated only between sunrise and sunset.
- not be operated at a speed of more than 6 knots within 10 metres of the shore.
