**Title**

1. This notice may be cited as the *Cook Shire Council (Making of Local Laws) Notice (No. 2) 2016*.

**Commencement**

2. This notice commences on the date that it is published in the Gazette.

**Making of local law**

3. Pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act 2009*, the Cook Shire Council made *Amending Subordinate Local Law No. 1 (Miscellaneous Subordinate Local Laws) 2016* by resolution on 19 July 2016.
4. The object of *Amending Subordinate Local Law No. 1 (Miscellaneous Subordinate Local Laws) 2016* is to —
  - (a) amend *Subordinate Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2016* to —
    - (i) increase the number of people that may attend a private function in a public place from 20 to 30 people to be consistent with other local laws;
    - (ii) exempt events that occur at the Cooktown Event Centre complex from obtaining a permit under the local laws;
    - (iii) exempt events that occur inside a building located on land zoned for community use from requiring a permit under the local laws;
    - (iv) exempt events that occur on a private residence within the urban area that involves less than 30 people from requiring a permit under the local laws.
  - (b) amend *Subordinate Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2016* to —
    - (i) correct a typographical error;
    - (ii) re-number paragraphs.

- (c) amend *Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas Facilities and Roads) 2016* to—

- (i) amend the time self-contained recreational vehicles may park in an area from 2 nights or 48 hours over a 14 day period to “7 consecutive nights, for no more than a total of 14 nights within a 30 day period.”

- (d) amend *Subordinate Local Law No. 5 (Parking) 2016* to—

- (i) declare an “off-street regulated parking area” for self-contained recreational vehicles at Cooktown Racecourse.
