

NOTICE TO MARINERS

295 (T) of 2023

Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 30 June 2023

Area: Brisbane pilotage area
Locality: Town Reach, Brisbane River
Activity: Temporary Gazetted Speed Limit

Mariners are advised that:

a six-knot speed limit will be in force with effect from 2359 hours on Friday, 30 June 2023 in the Town Reach of the Brisbane River. The gazetted six knot limit is in the waters of the Town Reach bounded by an imaginary line:

- from a position at the Holman Street ferry position latitude 27°27.945'S, longitude 153°02.035'E,
- across the Brisbane River in a westerly direction to position latitude 27°27.961'S, longitude 153°01.871'E,
- along the western bank of the Brisbane River in a southerly direction to position latitude 27°28.429'S, longitude 153°01.875'E,
- then across the Brisbane River in a easterly direction to position latitude 27°28.429'S, longitude 153°02.049'E,
- then back along the eastern bank of the Brisbane River to position latitude 27°27.945'S, longitude 153°02.035'E

Mariners are reminded to observe the 6-knot speed limit, navigate with extra caution and minimise wash when transiting the area.

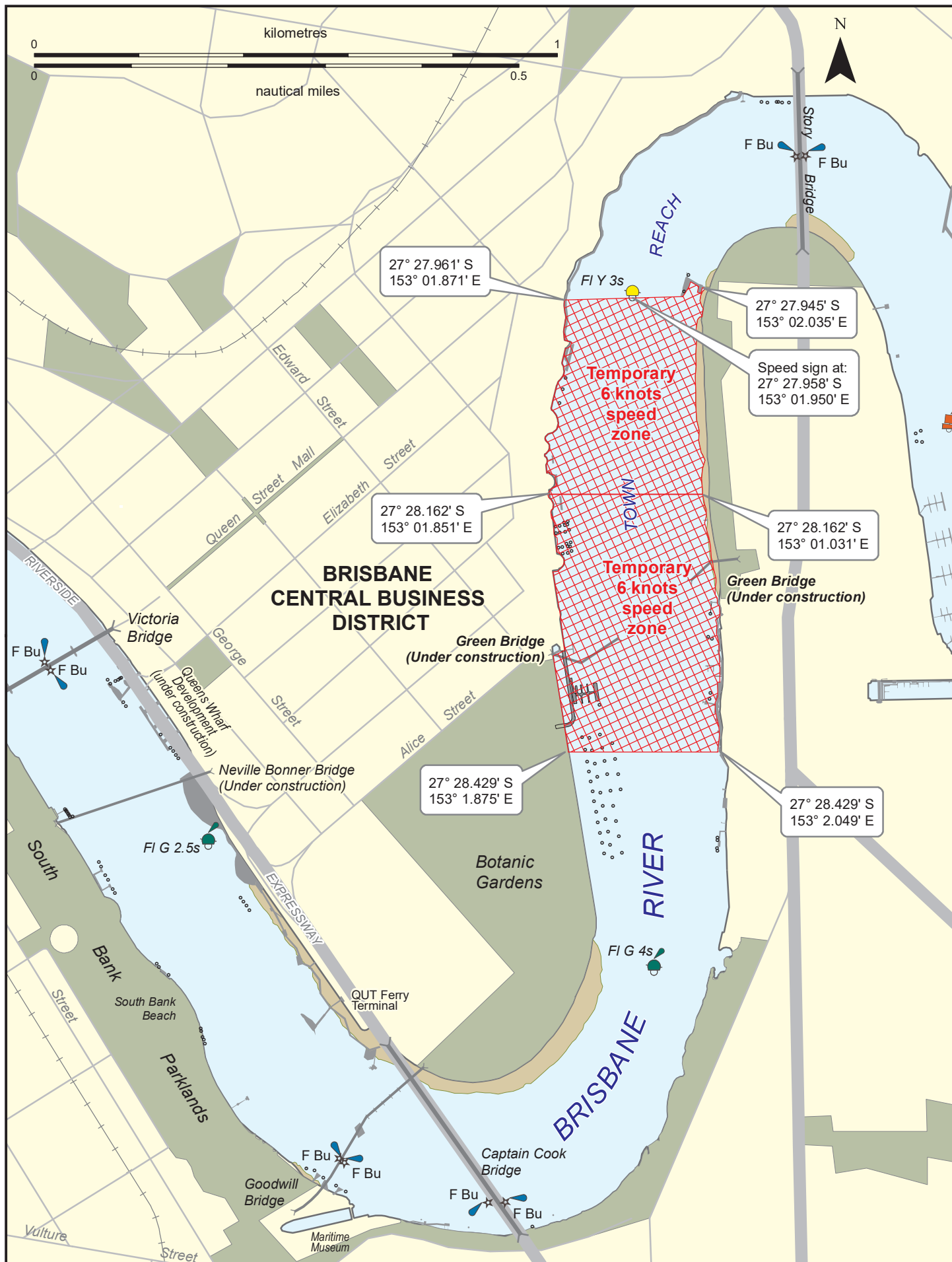
