



News Bulletin - June 2018 Family history research service launch

Hello subscribers.

To commemorate Queensland Day and the 5th anniversary of our historical records being made available to search and purchase online, we are launching our new <u>Family history</u> research service! This new search engine will go live at 8.30am on Wednesday 6 June 2018.

Our new service is person centric, meaning you only need to do one search to get birth, death and marriage results of a person. And we're very excited to finally be able to offer the purchase of source documents! As you may be aware, we have had the source documents digitised for some time, however the search engine was unable to be altered to offer the additional product. They are now available at the same price as historical images (\$21.40).

Source documents are the actual document recording the details of the event and feature original signatures of all parties. For example, if you were to search for John Rowswell Arnold, you would see the first two results are his birth and death records, and you would see that there is a source image available for his birth record. In this instance, the source image is the Baptisimal Certificate. Please note, not all records will have a source document available.

The service is also integrated with the Queensland Government's QGov account which enables you to login so that you can download your previous purchases at a later date. To enable this, you need to sign-up or login to your QGov account before you complete your transaction.


