## Absentee status change

Your absentee status for land tax changes if you:

- become an Australian citizen or permanent visa holder
- no longer hold Australian citizenship or a permanent visa, and ordinarily reside overseas
- as a foreign individual
  - spent greater than half the preceding financial year outside of Australia
  - spent significant periods of time during a financial year living or working overseas.

By completing and submitting this form, you are confirming that you are an absentee or an Australian citizen or a permanent visa holder and will comply with your obligations. This change to your residency status will continue to apply from the advised liability date until you notify of further changes.

You must give written notice to the Commissioner of State Revenue if your residency status changes. If you fail to comply, you will be required to pay any penalty tax and interest that may be imposed.

## Definitions

#### Absentee

An absentee is a person who does not ordinarily reside in Australia and does not hold Australian citizenship or a permanent visa.

#### Foreign individual

A foreign individual is a person who does not hold Australian citizenship or a permanent visa.

#### Individual

An individual is a natural person.

#### Liability date

The liability date is 30 June of the year you notify on the form.


