Create safer communities with a Community-based Crime Action grant.

Applications for the 2023–24 Community-based Crime Action grants are now open, with up to \$5 million in funds available for communities across Queensland.

Grants of \$5,000 to \$75,000 are available to support local communities, businesses and organisations with short-term programs and initiatives that will engage young people and deliver community-based prevention and early intervention solutions that make a difference and create safer communities.

The grants aim to keep communities safe by reducing youth crime and re-offending and helping young people involved in the youth justice system to build positive relationships and participation in their communities.

Prospective applicants are encouraged to consult with their community and engage local stakeholders to consider proposals.
