


Allied Health Research Plan: 2024-2026

The **Allied Health Research Plan 2024-2026** was led by Director of Allied Health Research Dr Rachel Wenke and Allied Health Research Team members A/Prof Laetitia Hattingh, Dr Shelley Roberts, Dr Rebecca Angus, and Dr Joanne Hilder with consultation from the Allied Health Research and Innovation Leadership Committee and key stakeholders including clinicians, managers, and external and internal partners.
