



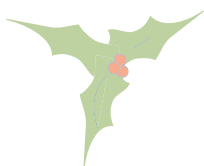

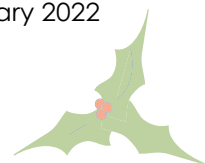

**NOTICE OF MINISTERIAL INFRASTRUCTURE DESIGNATION
MADE UNDER THE *PLANNING ACT 2016***

I, the Honourable Steven Miles MP, Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning, Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympics Infrastructure, give notice that under section 38 of the *Planning Act 2016*, I amended a Ministerial Infrastructure Designation (the amended MID) for the Coomera TAFE Expansion (Marine Centre of Excellence) on 26 November 2021.

The amended MID will take effect from 29 November 2021.

Description of the designated premises

The amended MID applies to premises located at 198 Foxwell Road, Coomera QLD 4209, formally described as Lots 1 and 2 on SP236127.

Type of infrastructure for which the premises were designated

The infrastructure is described under Schedule 5, Part 2 of the *Planning Regulation 2017*, as:

- Item 6: educational facilities

Requirements included in the amended MID

The amended MID includes requirements in relation to the location and scale of works, car parking, external works, landscaping, active transport, design/built form, stormwater management, vegetation management, mitigation of koala impacts, acoustics, bushfire hazard mitigation, construction management and servicing.

NOTIFICATION OF DECLARATION AND REVOCATION OF STATE-CONTROLLED ROADS

Notice is hereby given under sections 24 and 25 of the *Transport Infrastructure Act 1994*, that the roads or routes, or parts of the roads or routes described in the schedule are hereby declared or revoked as State-controlled roads, as the case may be. As required by the abovementioned sections of the *Transport Infrastructure Act 1994*, Balonne Shire Council has been notified and the declarations described in the schedule below are consistent with the department's transport infrastructure strategies.

THE SCHEDULE

That on and from 25 November 2021, the declaration of the State-controlled roads specified in Appendix I hereto, are revoked, and in lieu thereof, the road described in Appendix II hereto, is declared a State-controlled road, respectively, under and for the purposes of the *Transport Infrastructure Act 1994*.

The area (that is, alignment and width) of the State-controlled road described in Appendix II shall apply to the full width of the road corridor, where the existing trafficked route is contained within a surveyed road corridor (unless otherwise specified), provided that, where the existing trafficked route is through a State Reserve, State Forest, timber reserve, vacant State land or pastoral holding the area (that is, alignment and width) shall apply to 30 metres each side of the constructed centreline of the road pavement or surface.

CALL FOR TENDERS FOR GHG EXPLORATION PERMIT NOTICE (No 01) 2021

Short title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Call for Tenders for GHG Exploration Permit Notice (No 01) 2021* under the *Greenhouse Gas Storage Act 2009* (the Act).

Call for Tenders for a GHG exploration permit [s.33 of the Act]

2. This notice is a call for tenders for four GHG exploration permits (GHG permits) for four greenhouse gas storage areas described as QLR2021-1-1, QLR2021-1-2, QLR2021-1-3, QLR2021-1-4, in the Schedule to this notice. Pursuant to Part 3 of the Act, particular land may be excluded land for the GHG permits.

Lodgement & closing time

3. Tenders must be lodged with the Department of Resources before the closing time, being 11:00am (Australian Eastern Standard Time) on 4 March 2022.

- tender lodgement information;
- any proposed conditions of the GHG permit, other than mandatory conditions, that are likely to impact significantly on exploration in the proposed area;

- any criteria (special criteria), other than the work program criteria and capability criteria, proposed to be used to decide whether to grant the GHG permits, or to decide its provisions.
