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NOTICE OF AMENDMENT OF LAND DESIGNATED FOR COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE MADE UNDER THE SUSTAINABLE PLANNING ACT 2009

Amendment to a designation of land for community infrastructure has been made

I, MARK McARDLE MP, Minister for Energy and Water Supply, give notice that under the Sustainable Planning Act 2009, I have made a minor amendment to an earlier designation of land for community infrastructure.

The earlier designation was notified in the Queensland Government Gazette on 7 November 2014 as land on which Queensland Electricity Transmission Corporation Limited, trading as Powerlink Queensland, proposes to build the Yuleba North to Clifford Creek and Yuleba North to Dinoun South Transmission Lines Project.

Reason for amendment

The reason for the amendment is that the type of community infrastructure for which the land has been designated did not include the correct description for the number of 132kV transmission lines between the approved Dinoun South Substation and Australia Pacific LNG's Combabula Substation.

Details of the amendment to the earlier designation

The following type of community infrastructure for which the land has been designated is operating works under the *Electricity Act 1994*. Specifically, the following operating works are to be included in the designation for Easement E on SP263274:

Two new 132kV transmission lines about 143 metres in length between the approved Dinoun South Substation and Australia Pacific LNG's Combabula Substation.
