NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON DRAFT AMENDMENT TO THE STANDARD PLANNING SCHEME PROVISIONS

I, the Honourable Jeff Seeney MP, Deputy Premier and Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning, do hereby notify under section 60 of the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009* I have prepared a draft amendment to the standard planning scheme provisions under chapter 2, part 6, division 3, subdivision 2 of the Act.

The draft amendment may be cited as the draft Queensland Planning Provisions version 4.0 (the QPP).

Any person may make a written submission about any aspect of the draft amendment to the QPP. The submission must be a properly made submission under the Act to be accepted.

A properly made submission must:

- be made to the Minister
- be received on or before 16 January 2015
- be in writing and, unless the submission is made electronically, is signed by each person who made the submission
- state the name and residential or business address of each person who made the submission; and
- state the grounds of the submission and the facts and circumstances relied on in support of the grounds.
