Queensland First Home Owners' Grant by Statistical Area

Explanatory notes

The Queensland First Home Owners' Grant (QFHOG) is a state government initiative to help first home owners to get their new first home sooner. Under the current QFHOG scheme, introduced on 1 July 2016, an eligible applicant will receive \$15,000 or \$20,000 towards buying or building a new house, unit or townhouse (valued at less than \$750,000). The value of the grant depends on the contract date:

- \$15,000 for contracts dated 1 July 2018 or later, or
- \$20,000 for contracts dated from 1 July 2016 to 30 June 2018.
- 1. Figures are reported using the Australian Statistical Geography Standard (ASGS) Postcodes to Statistical Area Level 4 correspondences tables (Source: Australian Bureau of Statistics Cat. No. 1270.0.55.006).
- 2. Applications figures incorporate all applications received under the Queensland First Home Owners' Grant scheme.
- 3. Payments figures incorporate applications that have been approved and paid to the applicant/s under the Queensland First Home Owners' scheme.
- 4. Figures for regions of Darling Downs Maranoa and Queensland Outback are consolidated due to confidentiality reasons.
- 5. Due to the lag between an application being received and being paid, there may be fewer applications received than paid in some months.
