

## **District profile**

#### **Overview**

The Northern District covers an area of about 80,249km², or around 4.6% of Queensland. It extends from the Cardwell Range in the north to 50km south of Lake Buchanan and from Townsville in the east to the west of Charters Towers.

The district has an estimated residential population of about 233,907 or around 5.0% of Queensland's total population.<sup>1</sup>

The district looks after about 1,142km of other state-controlled roads and about 515km of the National Network.

### District program highlights

In 2013-14 we completed:

- repairs to flood damaged roads across the district as part of Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA), jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- improvements to the Woolcock Street and Mather Street intersection in Townsville.

In 2014-15 we will:

 commence the Townsville Ring Road Stage 4 project to provide a high-speed bypass of Townsville for heavy and commercial vehicles, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government

- continue duplication of a section of the Bruce Highway from two to four lanes, from Vantassel Street to Stuart Road in Townsville, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- complete construction of the Bruce Highway upgrade between Sandy Corner and Collinsons Lagoon, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- complete a realignment of traffic lanes at Dalrymple Road and Banfield Drive, Mount Louisa
- complete an upgrade of the Melton Black Drive and Macarthur Drive intersection on the Bruce Highway in Townsville, funded by the Australian Government.

### **Future plans**

We are continuing to plan for the future transport requirements of residents in the Northern district.

In 2014-15 we plan to:

- continue planning work associated with the Bruce
  Highway Action Plan, including improving flood
  immunity around Cattle Creek and Frances Creek (south
  of Ingham) and the Haughton River Floodplain (south of
  Townsville)
- continue investigation into pavement widening and rehabilitation south of Home Hill to north of Ingham
- commence planning for the duplication of Abbott Street from Lakeside Drive to Brooks Street.
