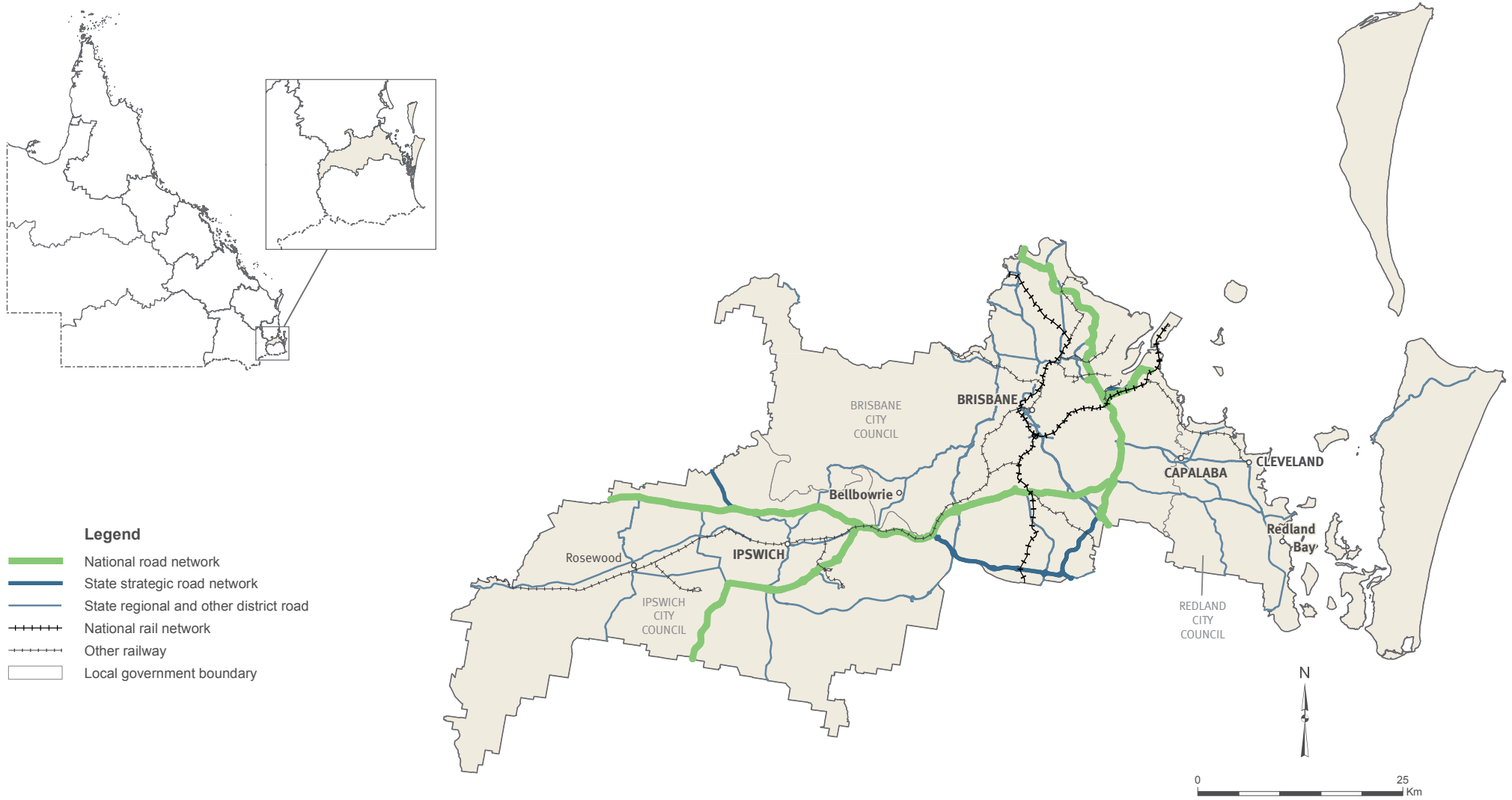

## District profile

### Overview

The Metropolitan district covers an area of about 2,968km<sup>2</sup>, or around 0.2% of Queensland. It straddles the Brisbane River and extends from Mount Glorious in the north down to the Logan River, and from Point Lookout in the east to west of Helidon and the major centre of Ipswich.

The district has an estimated residential population of about 1,461,733 or around 31.4% of Queensland's total population.<sup>1</sup>

The district looks after about 409km of other state-controlled roads, about 113km of the National Network and is responsible for marine infrastructure and busway assets. Other major transport infrastructure in the region includes cycling facilities delivered as part of the South East Queensland Principal Cycle Network Plan.

### District program highlights

In 2013-14 we completed:

- construction of a four-lane underpass at the Kessels Road and Mains Road intersection at MacGregor, funded by the Australian Government
- construction of the South-East Busway extension from Eight Mile Plains to Rochedale
- construction of The Gap Park 'n' Ride
- upgrade of the intersection on Samford Road at Keperra Retirement Village, Keperra

- construction of Stage 2 of the Darra to Springfield Transit Corridor, including a rail duplication from Richlands to Springfield, new rail stations at Springfield and Springfield Lakes, and safety and capacity upgrades to the Centenary Highway south of the Logan Motorway.

In 2014-15 we will:

- commence the Gateway Upgrade North project, between Nudgee and Bracken Ridge, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- complete construction of the North Brisbane Bikeway linking Brisbane's CBD to the northern suburbs
- complete construction of Warrigal Road Greenlink to improve the bus network
- continue widening the Mount Gravatt – Capalaba Road, between Broadwater Road and Mount Petrie Road to six lanes, as part of the Gateway Upgrade South project, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- continue widening a portion of the Centenary Highway to six lanes, in conjunction with the Legacy Way tunnel project and the Moggill Road interchange upgrade
- complete construction of an additional northbound lane on the Gateway Motorway between Sandgate Road and the Deagon Deviation, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government

- complete construction of the Warrego Highway and Brisbane Valley Highway Intersection Upgrade at Blacksoil, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.

### Future plans

We are continuing to plan for the future transport requirements of residents in the Metropolitan district.

In 2014-15 we plan to:

- develop a value for money strategy for the Pacific Motorway between the Captain Cook Bridge and Underwood Road
- develop a staging strategy for upgrades along the Warrego Highway to meet increasing demands
- commence planning to improve freight and passenger movements along Beaudesert Road and Granard Road to the Logan Motorway.
