District profile

Overview

The North Coast District covers an area of about 10,546km², or around 0.6% of Queensland. It extends from Noosa in the north to Redcliffe in the south and from Caboolture in the east to west of Fsk.

The district has an estimated residential population of about 762,699 or around 16.4% of Queensland's total population.¹

The district looks after about 1,230km of other state-controlled roads and about 129km of the National Network.

District program highlights

In 2013-14 we completed:

- intersection improvements on the Bruce Highway at Gardners Road and Pomona Connection Road, funded by the Australian Government
- Stage 1 of the Burpengary-Caboolture Road (Morayfield Road) upgrade between Graham Road and Gaffield Street
- construction of the Maroochydore Bus Station located on Horton Parade near Cornmeal and Sunseeker Parade, near Sunshine Plaza
- replacement of Grigor Bridge on Maleny-Kenilworth Road which crosses the Mary River at Conondale as part of the Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA), jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.

In 2014-15 we will:

- continue construction of the Moreton Bay Rail Link project, a dual-track passenger rail line from Petrie Station to Kippa-Ring Station, jointly funded by the Australian Government, Queensland Government and Moreton Bay Regional Council
- continue duplication of the Bruce Highway (Cooroy to Curra) from Cooroy Southern Interchange to Sankeys Road (Section A), jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- complete construction of an upgrade to Frizzo Road northbound entry ramp to the Bruce Highway and associated works, funded by the Australian Government
- complete a program of interchange upgrades on the Bruce Highway between Caboolture and Caloundra, funded by the Australian Government
- commence Stage 1 upgrading of the Bruce Highway between Caloundra Road and the Sunshine Motorway, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- provide funding to Somerset Regional Council for the construction of overtaking lanes on a section of the Brisbane Valley Highway, south of Toogoolawah, as part of the Queensland Government's Royalties for the Regions Program
- complete drainage and safety improvements on Mooloolaba Road between Foote Avenue and Buderim Pines Drive.

Future plans

We are continuing to plan for the future transport requirements of residents in the North Coast district.

In 2014-15 we plan to:

- identify future requirements and develop options for upgrading the Bruce Highway between Pine River and Caloundra Road
- analyse options and confirm the southern alignment for the North-South Arterial crossing of the Pine River
- investigate value for money solutions to the Mooloolah River Interchange.
