Activity: Impact Piling Works

Mariners are advised that:

Impact piling works will be carried out at Dalrymple Bay Coal Terminal Berth 1 within daylight hours from Sunday 20 July 2025 until Friday 25 July 2025.

Operations will be conducted from the vessels Black Panther, PMG183W and Mighty Chieftain.

Appropriate day signals will be exhibited, and a listening watch will be maintained on VHF channels 10 and 16.

Impact Piling Works will generate loud noise both above and underwater in the vicinity of the above location. A 2km restricted zone will be in place around the pile, approximate position 21°15.031'S, 149°18.352'E as indicated on the image below.

Above water – 30m from vessel location, all persons to wear Class 5 hearing protection

Below water – All underwater diving operations to cease within 2km radius of vessel (Blue Circle as indicated on below image)





An Exclusion Zone will be in place around the pile, bound by the below coordinates and indicated on the image below:

- 21° 14.926'S, 149° 18.280'E
- 21° 14.875'S, 149° 18.377'E
- 21° 15.016′S, 149° 18.463′E
- 21° 15.066'S, 149° 18.366'E

Mariners should navigate with caution in the area.
