**NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF A MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER
SECTION 124(5)(A) OF THE *BIOSECURITY ACT 2014***

Pursuant to section 124 of the *Biosecurity Act 2014* (the Act), I have made a Movement Control Order directed at prohibiting the movement of varroa mite and its carriers into, out of and within the area outlined in Map 1 and describing control methods.

The Movement Control Order provides specific details regarding the controlled biosecurity matter, the area to which the order relates, the purpose of the Order and the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements that must be complied with by persons to whom the order applies.
