Constitution of Queensland 2001

ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ORDER (No. 1) 2020

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Short Title

1. This order in council may be cited as the *Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 1) 2020*.

- This notice is made under the *Public Service Act 2008* and may be cited as the *Public Service Departmental Arrangements Notice (No.1) 2020*.

Commencement

- This notice commences on 11 May 2020.

Establishment and Declaration of Government Entities

- Under sections 14(2) and 15(a) of the Act, that part of the Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning responsible for infrastructure and planning is established as a government entity and declared to be part of the Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning.
- Under sections 14(2) and 15(a) of the Act, that part of the Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning responsible for providing corporate and executive services to the government entity established under part 3 of this notice is established as a government entity and declared to be part of the Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning.
- Under sections 14(2) and 15(a) of the Act, that part of the Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning responsible for state development, excluding responsibility for coordinated projects associated with mining and mining infrastructure and regional economic development, is established as a government entity and declared to be part of the Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning.
- Under sections 14(2) and 15(a) of the Act, that part of the Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning responsible for providing corporate and executive services to the government entity established under part 5 of this notice is established as a government entity and declared to be part of the Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning.

Renaming of Departments

- Under section 15(e) of the Act, the Department of Innovation and Tourism Industry Development is renamed the Department of State Development, Tourism and Innovation.
- Under section 15(e) of the Act, the Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning is renamed the Department of Regional Development and Manufacturing.

Amalgamations and Declarations

- Under sections 14(2) and 15(b) of the Act, the government entities established under Parts 3 and 4 of this notice are amalgamated with, and declared to be part of, Queensland Treasury.
- Under sections 14(2) and 15(b) of the Act, the government entities established under Parts 5 and 6 of this notice are amalgamated with, and declared to be part of, the Department of State Development, Tourism and Innovation.

Declaration of Departments and Titles of Office for Chief Executives

- Under section 14(1) of the Act, within the schedule, an entity in column 1 is declared to be a department of government. The title specified in column 2 is the title of office for the chief executive of the stated department and is included for information only and does not form part of this notice.
