1. Name of Declaration

This Declaration is the *Emergency Prohibited Matter Declaration 2025*.

2. Commencement and Duration

- (1) This Declaration commences on 9 April 2025.
- (2) This Declaration has effect until revoked or amended.

3. Definitions

(1) In this Declaration:

the Act means the Biosecurity Act 2014.

(2) Unless otherwise defined in this Declaration, words and expressions that are defined in the Act have the same meaning in this Declaration.

4. **Declaration**

The biosecurity matter, *Varroa destructor* declared to be prohibited matter under section 29(1) of the Act is no longer prohibited matter.
