To book a visit, please phone (07) 4123 7488 (and follow the prompts) on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday between 9am – 11am and 12:30pm – 3pm and Thursday between 9am - 11am. Alternately, you can book online at <u>MCC Online Visit Booking</u> from 7.30am on Saturday for the following week.

Booking requests will be processed in order of date and time received. For bookings received via the Online Portal, a confirmation email will be sent to the primary person confirming the date/time of the visit booking by close of business the day before the visit/virtual visit.

Contact visits are subject to approval by the General Manager following a criminal history check. Visitors are subject to non-contact or virtual visits pending this approval, which may take up to six weeks.

Virtual visits may include a maximum of three adults and unlimited children.

The centre is located approximately 7 kilometres north of Maryborough. Travelling north along the Bruce Highway, continue past the Caltex Service Station (on right), under the overhead railway bridgeand a further 1.3 kilometres along turn left onto Rampton Road. Follow this road 1 kilometre to Stein Road and the centre.

Other Information

Tobacco and other smoking related products are prohibited items within a correctional centre. Tobacco and other smoking related products must not be taken into a correctional centre and must be either secured in a motor vehicle or visitor locker. No smoking is permitted anywhere in the grounds of a correctional centre, including car parks, walkways, visits processing etc.

Visitors are no longer required to wear a face mask. A visitor may be directed to wear a face mask where they display cold or flu like symptoms. Visiting restrictions remain in place if a visitor is a COVID diagnosed person or COVID close contact.
