Mariners are advised that the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) will be undertaking underwater inspections and maintenance works on the Bribie Island Bridge, spanning the Pumicestone Passage. These works are part of the department's structures maintenance program to ensure the ongoing safety and serviceability of the bridge.

Routine visual underwater inspections will be conducted to confirm the scope of maintenance required. As part of the works, several bridge piles will be wrapped in protective polyethylene liners, and concrete repairs will be undertaken. A pontoon and boat will be positioned near the bridge, with surface markers indicating the locations of divers undertaking inspections and maintenance.

The works are scheduled to commence in early July 2025 and are expected to take approximately four months to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. Activities will be carried out during the day, Monday to Friday, between 6:00 am and 6:00 pm.

Mariners are requested to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the works and adhere to all displayed markers and instructions. Please note that these works will not impact vehicular traffic on the Bribie Island Bridge.
