Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 11 July 2025

- Area: Brisbane pilotage area
- Locality: Town Reach, Brisbane River
- Activity: Bridge maintenance

Mariners are advised that:

Maintenance works will be carried out on the Kangaroo Point bridge between 0700 hours and 1600 hours, Monday 14 July to Friday 25 July, excluding weekends.

The works involve a 14-metre barge and associated work boats that will run anchors and set up to operate along the length of the bridge. The barge will be moved and positioned by the workboats as required, and moored outside of the navigation channel outside work hours.

During work hours, the bridge clearance height will be reduced to approximately 10 metres (measured at HAT) due to machinery suspended beneath the bridge as part of the maintenance works.

All vessels navigating under the bridge are advised to proceed with caution.

Latitude and longitude positions are on WGS84 horizontal datum and are compatible with GDA2020 datum.
