

NOTICE TO MARINERS

249 (T) of 2025

Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 12 June 2025

Area: Brisbane pilotage area
Locality: Mooloolaba River
Activity: beacon replacement and refurbishment

Mariners are advised that:

Works for the Mooloolaba beacon replacement and refurbishment has commenced, with the barge 'Aquila' on station and is extracting beacons 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 13. The barge will exhibit day shapes and lights as required by Collision Regulations, as well as yellow lights on its extremities whilst at anchor. The works will be conducted between the hours of 6:00am and 6:00pm, and is expected to be completed by Monday 16 June 2025. Mariners must carefully consider the position of the 'Aquila' when navigating the Mooloolaba River.

The removed beacons will be replaced temporarily with buoys, with the buoys displaying the same flash sequence as the respective beacons being removed.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when transiting the area
