LOCAL PLANNING INSTRUMENT No. 1 OF 2025
(ACCOMMODATION HOTEL INCENTIVE MEASURES)**

Notice is given under section 23 of the *Planning Act 2016* that, on 21 November 2024, Sunshine Coast Regional Council adopted *Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 1 of 2025 (Accommodation Hotel Incentive Measures)*.

The Temporary Local Planning Instrument suspends and affects the operation of aspects of the *Sunshine Coast Planning Scheme 2014*, relating to the development of a *resort complex* or *short-term accommodation use (where for an accommodation hotel)*.

The purpose of the Temporary Local Planning Instrument is to provide a targeted set of planning provisions to encourage the development of new *accommodation hotels* and to facilitate the redevelopment of existing premises for *accommodation hotels* that are of at least an upscale standard or 4.0 star rating. To achieve this purpose, the Temporary Local Planning Instrument provides additional building height allowances and a reduced on-site car parking rate for eligible *accommodation hotels*.

The Temporary Local Planning Instrument applies to land within the Maroochydore and Caloundra centre areas, included in the zones identified on the map in Schedule 1 of the Temporary Local Planning Instrument.

The Temporary Local Planning Instrument will commence on and from **4 April 2025** and will cease to have effect on **4 April 2027**, unless repealed sooner.

From the date of commencement, a copy of the Temporary Local Planning Instrument will be available for inspection or purchase at Council's Customer Contact Counter located at 54 First Avenue, Maroochydore or can be viewed and downloaded from <https://www.sunshinecoast.qld.gov.au/development/planning-documents/temporary-local-planning-instruments>.

Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act 1994
*Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2016***NOTIFICATION OF EXEMPTION**

Maritime Safety Queensland

I, Kell Dillon, General Manager, Maritime Safety Queensland, pursuant to section 18A of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act 1994*, exempt persons 10 years to 15 years from Chapter 4, Part 1, Division 2, section 57 of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2016* requiring a person to hold a licence to operate a recreational ship as its master, subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

- The ship is in all other respects operated in accordance with the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act 1994* and the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2016*;
- The exemption applies only to operations in the Sandy Hook Reach of the Burnett River authorised under an aquatic event authority granted to the Bundaberg Powerboat Club Incorporated;
- The aquatic event is managed in compliance with the *Racing and Safety Rules* published by the Australian Power Boat Association, and the *Racing Rules and Regulations and Summation of Safety/Risk Management for Events* published by the Bundaberg Powerboat Club Incorporated, as in force at the date of the aquatic event;
- There is full and documented compliance with the provisions in the documents listed in paragraph (c) relating to:
 - Training and assessment of junior competitors;
 - Separate and specific race briefings for junior competitors;
- The exemption applies only to persons operating ships within the age and propulsion power parameters specified by Class in accordance with the *Racing and Safety Rules* published by the Australian Power Boat Association:
 - Class J2 for persons between 10 and 15 years operating ships with a maximum propulsion power of 7.5kW (10HP);
 - Class J3 for persons between 12 and 15 years operating ships with a maximum propulsion power of 11.2kW (15HP);
- The Regional Harbour Master (Gladstone) is advised in writing of any change to the documents listed in paragraph (c) affecting the matters referred to in paragraphs (d) or (e) at least one month prior to holding an aquatic event with participation by persons aged 10 to 15 years.
- This new Notice of Exemption supersedes the Notice of Exemption dated the 20 March 2023.
