OTHER SUBMISSIONS: before 12 noon on a Wednesday for that Friday's edition.

PAYMENTS: before close of business on a Wednesday for that Friday's edition.

Below is the process for payment to ensure the notification is gazetted.

The next step is as follows:

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1. Type in the quotation number **GAZ000XX/14 or VAC000XX/14** as shown in the right hand top corner of your quotation.

TAKING OF EASEMENT NOTICE BY THE MINISTER (No 13) 2014

Short title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Taking of Easement Notice* by the Minister (*No 13*) 2014.

Easements taken [ss.6 and 9(7) of the Act]

2. The easements described in Schedule 2 are taken by Central SEQ Distributor-Retailer Authority trading as Queensland Urban Utilities for works for reticulation of water purposes and vests in Central SEQ Distributor-Retailer Authority trading as Queensland Urban Utilities on and from 19 September 2014.

Rights and obligations

3. That the rights and obligations conferred and imposed by each easement include the matters set out in Schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1

1. Definitions and references

1.1 Definitions

In this easement:

Authorised Persons means employees, agents and contractors of, and other persons authorised, by QUU.

Easement Area means that part of the land over which this easement is taken.

Owner means any person who has an estate, interest, right, power or privilege in, over, or in relation to the land subject to the Easement Area and that person's administrators, assignees and successors.

QUU means:

- (a) the Central SEQ Distributor-Retailer Authority (trading as Queensland Urban Utilities), established under section 8 of the South-East Queensland Water (Distribution and Retail Restructuring) Act 2009 and its assignees and successors; and
- (b) if the context permits, Authorised Persons. Water Supply Works means all water reticulation mains or pipes for carrying water supplied by QUU, all ancillary plant, equipment (including pumps and pump stations and water reservoirs), fittings and attachments, and works of any nature to protect or support any of them.

1.2 References to things on Easement Area

In this easement, and unless the context indicates a contrary intention:

- (a) a reference to a thing on, or the doing of any thing on or in respect of, land in the Easement Area includes a reference to a thing, or the doing of the thing in, through, over, across or under the land; and
- (b) a reference to the Easement Area includes the land's surface, sub-surface and strata above the surface.

2. QUU's rights

QUU has the following rights under this easement:

- (a) to transmit, or permit to be transmitted:
 - (i) water in and through Water Supply Works, on the Easement Area;
- (b) to construct, place, lay, deepen, widen, inspect, clean, maintain, change, add to, remove, repair, replace, relay, renew, use and manage the Water Supply Works on the Easement Area at all times and from time to time;
- (c) to do anything to remedy or prevent any infringement of its rights under this easement by an Owner or to enforce any obligation of an Owner under this easement, at the relevant Owner's cost; and

- (d) in order to exercise the rights in clauses 2(a) to (c):
 - (i) enter the Easement Area, remain on it, and pass and repass on it, with or without vehicles, machinery, plant, equipment, tools and materials;
 - (ii) place on the Easement Area the machinery, plant, equipment, tools and materials required to exercise those rights and leave them there;
 - (iii) dig into, sink shafts in, and erect scaffolding on and open and break up the Easement Area;
 - (iv) remove and dispose of spoil created by the exercise of those rights;
 - (v) construct and maintain on the Easement Area those access tracks, gates and ancillary works that QUU reasonably considers necessary;
 - (vi) clear vegetation from the Easement Area by any method and burn it off;
 - (vii) remove fences or gates on the Easement Area; and
 - (viii) do anything else on the Easement Area that the Grantee considers reasonably necessary to exercise those rights.

3. Owner's obligations

An Owner must not, unless it has QUU's prior written consent:

- (a) erect, install or lay any structure or other thing on the Easement Area;
- (b) remove from or stockpile on the Easement Area soil, sand, gravel or any other substance or material;
- (c) install concrete, bitumen or other pavement or driveways on the Easement Area or gardens or landscaping involving concrete, brick or other permanent materials or otherwise build over the Water Supply Works;
- (d) alter the ground level, or alter or disturb the existing grades of the Easement Area or change its topography;
- (e) inundate the Easement Area with water;
- (f) plant any tree or other vegetation or crop on the Easement Area;
- (g) light a fire on the Easement Area;
- (h) construct any road or other earthwork on the Easement Area; or
- (i) do or cause or permit anything (including granting rights to another person) in connection with the Easement Area that could obstruct or interfere with the Water Supply Works or their proper and effective use or the proper exercise of QUU's rights under this easement.

4. Property in Water Supply Works

The Water Supply Works are QUU's property and do not become an Owner's property.

5. Exercise of QUU's rights

- (a) In exercising QUU's rights under this easement, QUU must, at its own cost:
 - (i) ensure all work is done in a proper and workmanlike manner; and
 - (ii) comply with all relevant laws.
- (b) This easement does not affect any rights or powers QUU may have under a statute, including the Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008 and the South-East Queensland Water (Distribution and Retail Restructuring) Act 2009.
