<b>Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required</b>	<p>The Gaming Machine Amendment Regulation 2025 (Amendment Regulation) seeks to extend a trial relating to the authorised sale of gaming machine operating authorities for hotels.</p> <p>Under the trial conditions, which have existed since 1 July 2022, a reduced proportion of the total amount received from the sale of authorities is to be paid into the consolidated fund. Normally this proportion is 33 percent. Under trial conditions, it is 15 percent. The Amendment Regulation seeks to extend the trial conditions for another three years, to 30 June 2028.</p> <p>The proposal relates to a matter substantially similar to the imposition of taxation or a royalty and no regulatory impact analysis is required under the Queensland Government <i>Better Regulation Policy</i>.</p>
