Type of infrastructure for which the premises were designated The infrastructure is described under Schedule 5, Part 2 of the *Planning Regulation 2017*, as:

 Item 16: social or affordable housing that is provided by a registered provider or a registered entity under the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act 2012(Commonwealth).

Requirements included in the MID

The MID includes requirements in relation to the location and scale of the development, stormwater management, car parking, active transport, external works/upgrades, acoustics, waste collection, design/built form, landscaping, fencing, lighting, refuse and plant screening, construction management, information signage, servicing, geotechnical conditions and acid sulfate soils.

NOTIFICATION OF DANGER TO MARINE SAFETY

This notice revokes and replaces the "Notification of Danger to Marine Safety" on page 290 in Queensland Government Gazette No. 29 published 28 February 2025.

I, Captain Frank D'Souza, Harbour Master, Maritime Safety Queensland (MSQ), pursuant to Section 197(2) of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2016*, state that the anchoring, berthing, mooring or operation of a ship (other than a ship operated by or exempted by the entities listed in Column 2) in the waters described in Column 1 for the periods of 1 hour prior, and 30 minutes after, each space launch from Bowen Orbital Spaceport, Bowen, endangers marine safety.

Note 1: The owner or master of a ship must not anchor, berth, moor or operate a ship in the waters described in Column 1 during the periods 1 hour prior, and 30 minutes after, each space launch from Bowen Orbital Spaceport, Bowen.

s.197(1) Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2016.

Maximum penalty – 100 penalty units.

Column 1 Column 2 Waters: Ships described as: Maritime Safety Part of the Abbot Point Pilotage area Queensland and/or described as commencing at the mean high-water Queensland Police. mark of the mainland nearest to position latitude 19°55.099' south, longitude 148°05.671' east, then generally northeast to position latitude 19°51.012' south, longitude 148°13.735' east, then generally southeast to position latitude 19°54.579' south, longitude 148°20.258' east, then generally southwest to the mean high-water mark of the mainland nearest to position latitude 19°57.646' south, longitude 148°13.417' east, then generally westward following the mean-high-water mark of the mainland back to the position of commencement. as shown on the map "S8o-53 - 2" prepared by Maritime Safety Queensland. and held at the Regional Harbour Master's office, Townsville.
