*Commissions of Inquiry Act 1950***COMMISSIONS OF INQUIRY ORDER (No. 1) 2025****Short title**

1. This Order in Council may be cited as the *Commissions of Inquiry Order (No. 1) 2025*.

Commencement

2. This Order in Council commences 1 July 2025.

Appointment of the Commission

3. UNDER the provisions of the *Commissions of Inquiry Act 1950*, the Governor in Council hereby appoints Paul Elias Anastassiou KC as Commissioner from 1 July 2025, to make full and careful inquiry in an open and independent manner with respect to:
 - a. Reforming the Residential Care System: Investigate models of care and the factors contributing to the growth and reliance on a billion-dollar residential care sector, including:
 - i. Analyse residential care in the historical context since the Carmody Inquiry and the increase in the use of Individual Placement Support Services and residential care.
 - ii. Investigate contemporary models around the world for the delivery of residential care, with a focus on best practice to support children who are more at risk.
 - iii. Consider what constitutes Quality of Care in both licensed and unlicensed providers, including from the perspectives of children and young people.
 - iv. Analyse contemporary models for licensing care providers.
 - v. Investigate the current state of the market of residential care providers operating under not-for-profit and for-profit models.
 - vi. Analyse previous Queensland government procurement and contracting process for residential care providers to identify opportunities to improve efficiency, transparency and accountability.
 - b. Fixing a broken system: reviewing the effectiveness of Queensland's child safety system to keep children safe, including:
 - i. The practices and procedures of the Department, specifically focussing on investigation, assessment, case work and reunification.
 - ii. Tertiary child protection interventions, including adoption, case management, service standards, and decision-making frameworks.
 - iii. The management, training, supervision, and ongoing oversight of case work within the Department.
 - iv. Departmental delivery structures including organisational culture; management structures and operations of regional service delivery (in each region).
 - v. The ability for information sharing across relevant agencies.
 - vi. Review Departmental governance, including financial, procurement and contracting delegations; and structures to manage conflict of interest and reporting.
 - vii. Whether Departmental frontline staff are resourced and supported to do their work and outline any deficiencies in the level of support, decision-making frameworks, case loads, and court and tribunal processes.
 - viii. Investigate the role of the privacy provisions of the *Child Protection Act 1999* and whether the provisions hamper transparency around system failures.
 - ix. Consider how to facilitate a culture of transparent reporting in the context of the Coaldrake Review.
 - x. Investigate the role of third parties including peak bodies and oversight bodies and their interaction with the Department and Minister in pursuit of system improvement, and any issues related to funding, reporting and their role in the media to ensure integrity and accountability.
 - xi. Evaluate Ministerial accountability of the child safety system since the Carmody Inquiry and the role the Minister has played in the performance of the Department.
 - xii. Review the effectiveness of the existing Complaints Process.
 - c. Safer Children: failures both systemic and policy that have impeded the ability of the Department responsible for the Child Safety portfolio (the Department) to provide support to families and protection to children at risk of harm in Queensland; and in particular to use case studies to:
 - i. Identify failures of the Department to intervene or to protect children, with a summary of findings and recommendations of collated coronial inquiries since the Carmody Inquiry and the establishment of the Child Death Review Board.

- ii. Review the decline in foster care and treatment of foster carers by the Department and by service providers contracted by the Department.
- iii. Review Child Placement breakdowns, with a focus on cases with more than four placements in a child's life.
- iv. Investigate the contributing factors for breakdown of placements due to lack of support for kinship carers.
- d. Safer Communities: Evaluate the effectiveness of the Department as a corporate parent and whether it is able to meet community expectations around parenting:
 - i. Investigate through case studies children subject to dual Youth Justice and Child Protection Orders or children under the Guardianship of the Department who have committed crimes and fall within the Making Queensland Safer Laws category and determine the failures of policy, process and practice that contributed to these children choosing a life of crime.
- e. Reviewing Queensland legislation about the protection of children, including the *Child Protection Act 1999* and *Adoption Act 2009*.
- f. Any other matter relevant to the inquiry.

Commission to report and make recommendations

- 4. AND directs that the Commissioner make full and faithful report on the aforesaid subject matter of the inquiry, including an executive summary.
- 5. AND makes recommendations that the Commissioner considers appropriate and feasible on:
 - a. Reforming the residential care system: which existing models of residential care best support children who have high complex needs (particularly those with a disability) and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children, and appropriate market structures to best deliver those models.
 - b. Fixing a broken system: the implementation and appropriateness of child safety practices; Departmental structure, governance and culture; the adequacy and effectiveness of current training programs for child safety staff; the extent to which leadership structures support accountability in the protection of children; Ministerial engagement and accountability; appropriate frontline resourcing; and third parties including peak bodies and oversight bodies.
 - c. Fixing a broken system: design and implementation plan for a new independent complaints escalation review process to escalate serious concerns about complex cases and restore critical support for families and carers.
 - d. Safer children: system design to support and facilitate foster care, kinship care and adoption in a modern best practice setting.
 - e. Safer communities: new models of care ensuring children are provided an opportunity for intervention and rehabilitation and that escalating risk or behaviours are managed in line with community safety expectations.
 - f. Any reforms to ensure that Queensland's child protection system achieves the best possible outcomes to protect children and support families.
 - g. Any legislative reforms required.
- 6. AND directs that the report be transmitted to the Honourable Premier and Minister for Veterans, the Honourable the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister for Integrity, and the Honourable the Minister for Families, Seniors and Disability Services and the Minister for Child Safety and the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence.
- 7. AND directs that the final report be provided to Government by 30 November 2026, AND that the Commissioner will determine whether any interim reports are to be provided before that date.

Application of Act

- 8. Pursuant to section 4(2) of the *Commissions of Inquiry Act 1950*, it is declared that all of the provisions of the *Commissions of Inquiry Act 1950* shall be applicable for the purposes of this inquiry, except for section 19C (Authority to use listening devices).

Conduct of Inquiry

- 9. The Commission may receive submissions from relevant individuals and entities and hold public and private hearings in such a manner and in such locations as determined by the Commissioner, as appropriate and convenient, in a way that promotes transparency.

Petroleum and Gas (Production and Safety) Act 2004
CALL FOR TENDERS FOR AUTHORITY TO PROSPECT NOTICE (No 01) 2025

Short title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Call for Tenders for Authority to Prospect Notice (No 01) 2025* under the *Petroleum and Gas (Production and Safety) Act 2004* (the Act).

Call for Tenders for Authority to Prospect [s.35 of the Act]

2. This notice invites tenders for nine Authorities to Prospect (ATPs) for nine proposed areas described as PLR2025-1-1, PLR2025-1-2, PLR2025-1-3, PLR2025-1-4, PLR2025-1-5, PLR2025-1-6, PLR2025-1-7, PLR2025-1-8 and PLR2025-1-9 in the Schedule to this notice. Pursuant to section 99 of the Act, particular land may be excluded land for an ATP.
3. The proposed term of each authority is six years.

Proposed work program

4. Tenders must be accompanied by a proposed initial work program (activities-based) for a period of six years.

Lodgement & closing time

5. Tenders must be lodged with the Department of Natural Resources and Mines, Manufacturing and Regional and Rural Development before the closing time being 11:00am (Australian Eastern Standard Time) on Thursday, 7 August 2025.

- whether a process for appointing a preferred tenderer involving a cash bid component is to be used for deciding the call;
- if any part of the proposed area of an authority is to be subject to an Australian market supply condition – the part of the proposed area and the condition;
- other relevant matters.

Add the following new provision:

1.3 Enduring Designation

Provide that Queensland Rail, the DTMR and CRRDA must do all things necessary to facilitate, from time to time, the equity transfer(s) of Rail Related Assets specified in the attached enduring designation of equity transfer made pursuant to AASB Interpretation 1038 *Contributions by Owners Made to Wholly-Owned Public Sector Entities* and FRR 4F *Equity, Contributions by Owners and Distributions to Owners* made after the date of this Amendment to Transfer Notice.

Amend the following provision:

Provision 4.1(a) is amended to delete the word “and”.

Provision 4.1(b) is amended to include the word “Operational” preceding the words “Rail Related Assets” and to delete the “.” at the end of the subparagraph and insert the following “; and”.

Add the following new **provision 4.1 (c)**:

any unknown or contingent liabilities directly or indirectly related to the Rail Related Assets and referred to in this Transfer Notice that arose or are in connection with the fact, event or circumstances which occurred after the relevant Handback Date transfer to Queensland Rail.

DESIGNATION OF EQUITY TRANSFER

Purpose

The purpose of this designation is to effect the transfer of equity for Rail Related Assets that have been constructed pursuant to the Cross River Rail – Rail, Integration and Systems Program Alliance Agreement from DTMR and CRRDA to Queensland Rail where the Rail Related Assets have been accepted by Queensland Rail for operational use.

Definitions

CRRDA means the Cross River Rail Delivery Authority;

DTMR means the Department of Transport and Main Roads;

Queensland Rail means Queensland Rail Limited ABN 71 132 181 090 or, to the extent applicable or necessary, Queensland Rail ABN 68 598 268 528.

Queensland Rail safety case for operational use means the inputs for entry into service (Gate 6a) are closed sufficient to commence revenue service;

Rail Related Assets mean the assets forming part of the RIS Works under the RIS PAA to be transferred from the Transferor to Queensland Rail in accordance with RIS PAA;

RIS PAA means the document titled “Cross River Rail – Rail, Integration and Systems Program Alliance Agreement” between the State of Queensland, CPB Contractors Pty Limited, UGL Engineering Pty Limited, AECOM Australia Pty Ltd, Jacobs Group (Australia) Pty Ltd and Queensland Rail Limited dated 25 August 2019;

RIS Works means the physical works which the participants under the RIS PAA are required to design, procure, manufacture, fabricate, supply, deliver, construct, install, integrate, commission, test and/or hand over in accordance with the RIS PAA;

Service Level Agreement means the document titled “*Service Level Agreement (SLA) – Cross River Rail Related Projects*” between the State of Queensland represented by DTMR and CRRDA, as varied from time to time;

Transferor means:

- generally – the State of Queensland acting through its agent the CRRDA; and
- in relation to the accounting treatment of the transfer of any Rail Related Asset funded by the State of Queensland represented by the DTMR but delivered by the CRRDA (including projects under the Service Level Agreement) – the State of Queensland represented by DTMR.

Recipient means Queensland Rail.

Designated Assets

Rail Related Assets within the RIS PAA are to be transferred from the Transferors to the Recipient pursuant to the RIS PAA as a result of decisions made by the owners or the respective Ministers as representatives of the owners in conjunction with the operationalisation of the Rail Related Assets.

Enduring Designation

This designation of equity transfer covers the Rail Related Assets, as outlined in **Attachment 1**, the transfer of which to Queensland Rail for operational use will occur progressively. The transfer will be completed as individual assets, in conjunction with the progressive operationalisation of the Rail Related Assets, until all the Rail Related Assets have been transferred. The designation of equity transfer is therefore an ‘enduring designation’ – valid from the day of approval until all the Rail Related Assets have been transferred, or a change in legislation, accounting standards or Government policy which requires this designation of equity transfer to be rescinded.

The equity transfer of Rail Related Assets will occur from time to time and, for each Rail Related Asset, on the relevant date when all of the conditions as outlined in **Attachment 2** are satisfied in respect of the Rail Related Asset.

Transfer Value

The agreed accounting value of the Rail Related Assets to be transferred will be equal to the current net book values of the relevant Rail Related Assets at the date of each transfer.

However, given the potential for timing differences in the identification and allocation of capital costs incurred, costs directly attributable to the construction of Rail Related Assets which are incurred or identified subsequent to the date of each transfer (Additional Costs) will also be eligible to be transferred to Queensland Rail under this Enduring Designation subject to appropriate accounting verification.

The Additional Costs eligible to be transferred to Queensland Rail under this Enduring Designation subject to appropriate accounting verification, includes Additional Costs for the Rail Related Assets, as outlined in **Attachment 1** and Additional Costs for the Rail Related Assets covered by the Section 78 Transfer Notice gazetted on 27 September 2024 [Vol 397, No 28] which relates to the transfer of Fairfield Station, Yeronga Station (including the Yeronga Station Pedestrian Overpass) and Mayne Yard North.

Accounting and Financial Reporting Compliance

This designation of equity transfer is made pursuant to AASB Interpretation 1038 *Contributions by Owners Made to Wholly-Owned Public Sector Entities* and FRR 4F *Equity, Contributions by Owners and Distributions to Owners*.

All transfers of Rail Related Assets under this designation of equity transfer are to be designated as capital contributions by owners for the Recipient, which is to be adjusted against the Transferors and Recipient's Contributed Equity.

To the extent that this would cause the Contributed Equity of the Transferors to reduce below \$0, the balance is to be adjusted against the Transferors' Accumulated Surplus. To the extent that this would cause the Transferors' Accumulated Surplus to reduce below \$0, the balance is to be recognised as an expense by the Transferors and corresponding revenue by the Recipient.

I, **Kell Dillon, General Manager, Maritime Safety Queensland**, pursuant to section 197 of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2016*, state that a person must not anchor or ground, in the waters described in column 1, a ship of a type described in column 2, for the period set out in column 3, with effect from 31 May 2025.

The restricted portion of waters is shown as Restricted Area on map S8o-54-5, prepared by Maritime Safety Queensland and held at the Regional Harbour Master's office in Brisbane and the Maritime Safety Queensland office in Mooloolaba. These coordinates have been plotted using GDA2020 datum.

For working out the length of a ship for this Notification of Danger to Marine Safety, the length is the distance measured from the foremost tip of the hull to the aftermost part of the hull, excluding appendages.
