Acquisition of Land Act 1967

TAKING OF EASEMENT NOTICE BY THE MINISTER (No 02) 2025

Short title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Taking of Easement Notice by the Minister (No 02) 2025*.

Easements taken [ss.6 and 9(7) of the Act]

2. The easements described in Schedule 2 are taken by Ipswich City Council for drainage purposes and vests in Ipswich City Council on and from 9 May 2025..

Rights and obligations

3. That the rights and obligations conferred and imposed by each easement include the matters set out in Schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1

The Council holds the easements for the purposes, powers, rights and liberties set out below.

1. INTERPRETATION

1.1 In this easement:

“**Burdened Land**” means the servient tenement (burdened land) identified in the Taking of Easement Notice and includes a separate reference to each separately identifiable part of that land.

“**Constructing Authority**” means the constructing authority named in the Taking of Easement Notice and also includes any person to which the rights or interest under this easement of the Constructing Authority are transferred, or pass by operation of law, from time to time.

“**Easement Purpose**” means, if the purpose specified in the Taking of Easement Notice is drainage, the drainage, passing or conveying of water (including stormwater) from, to, under, through or across the Burdened Land through pipes, channels, overland flow or by any other means.

“**Infrastructure**” means:

- (a) any plant, equipment or things for draining, passing, conveying or regulating or directing the passage, flow, collection, detention or retention of water or for other drainage purposes; and
- (b) pipes, drains, surface manholes, vents, marker posts, plates and any plant, equipment or fittings connected with or appurtenant to any of those things or the things listed in paragraph (a) of this definition.

“**Local Government Act**” means the same thing as in the *Local Government Act 2009*.

“**Taking of Easement Notice**” means the Taking of Easement Notice by the Minister (No 02) 2025 published in the

Government Gazette pursuant to the *Acquisition of Land Act 1967* (Qld).

“**Registered Owner**” means the Registered Owner of the Burdened Land, and also includes any person who becomes a registered owner of the Burdened Land, or who has an estate or interest in the Burdened Land, from time to time.

1.2 If the Registered Owner or the Constructing Authority consists of two or more persons at any time:

- (a) a reference in this easement to that party is to be read as a reference to each of those persons individually, and each combination of them jointly; and
- (b) those persons are bound and benefited by this easement both individually and in each combination of them jointly.

1.3 A reference in this easement to a person includes a reference to a body corporate, a local government and every other kind of legal person.

1.4 A reference in this easement to a provision or definition contained in a specific Act is taken:

- (a) to refer to that provision or definition as amended, relocated, re-enacted or consolidated from time to time; and
- (b) after the repeal of the provision or definition - to continue to refer to that provision or definition as it stood just before its repeal and to also refer to any replacement provision or definition which most closely deals with the same or the most closely similar subject matter either in the same Act as the original provision or definition or, if that Act is repealed, in some other Act which replaced the repealed Act or deals with the same or most closely similar subject matter to the repealed Act; and
- (c) in any case - to import any other legislative provisions (such as the definitions of other terms defined in the Act which are used in the provision or definition referred to or taken to be referred to in this easement, and the provisions of any relevant Acts Interpretation Act as they apply in the interpretation of that provision or definition) which are relevant in the interpretation of the provision or definition referred to or taken to be referred to in this easement in the same way as those legislative provisions are imported in the interpretation of the provision or definition.

1.5 The headings in this easement are for reference purposes only and are not to be used in interpreting this easement.

2. PURPOSE

- 2.1 The Constructing Authority has acquired an easement over the Burdened Land for the purposes of:
- the Easement Purpose; and
 - the installation, maintenance and removal of Infrastructure on, in or under the Burdened Land; and
 - the exercise by the Constructing Authority of the other rights given to the Constructing Authority by this easement or which the Constructing Authority has authority to undertake or engage in under a Local Government Act.
- 2.2 The Constructing Authority's rights and powers under this easement in relation to the Burdened Land are not exclusive to the Constructing Authority. However, the Registered Owner must not grant any rights to any person in relation to the Burdened Land if the granting of those other rights could conflict or interfere with any of the Constructing Authority's rights and powers under this easement.
- 3. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF CONSTRUCTING AUTHORITY**
- 3.1 The Constructing Authority may:
- install, repair, remove, replace, clean, clear and alter any Infrastructure on, in or under the Burdened Land from time to time (and, for this purpose, break open the surface of the Burdened Land and dig into the surface of the Burdened Land); and
 - inspect or survey the Burdened Land from time to time; and
 - undertake mowing, slashing and vegetation control or removal on the Burdened Land from time to time; and
 - enter the Burdened Land for the purpose of doing or getting ready to do any of those things; and
 - pull down or break open any fencing on or adjacent to the Burdened Land in order to enter it (but only after giving reasonable prior notice to the Registered Owner if any livestock are contained within the fenced area); and
 - take anything onto the Burdened Land (and any other land owned or occupied by the Registered Owner) when entering it and use and operate what has been taken onto the Burdened Land; and
 - stockpile on the Burdened Land any Infrastructure or items for or relating to the installation or removal of Infrastructure by the Constructing Authority before or during the installation or after the removal of any Infrastructure by the Constructing Authority; and
 - stockpile on the Burdened Land any soil or matter dug up on or from under the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority for a reasonable period; and
 - temporarily restrict access to the Burdened Land or parts of it, by whatever means the Constructing Authority thinks fit including fencing off the Burdened Land or parts of it, and doing other things to provide for the security of Infrastructure of the Constructing Authority, items referred to in paragraph (g) or soil referred to in paragraph (h); and
 - run and pass water, fluids and substances of any description to, from, through or about the Burdened Land or any Infrastructure installed by the Constructing Authority on the Burdened Land; and
 - do anything the Constructing Authority reasonably requires to do in connection with or in order to exercise any of the powers listed above or to enjoy the benefit of this easement for the purposes specified in subclause 2.1.
- 3.2 If in exercising its rights and powers under this easement the Constructing Authority digs up any soil or matter from or from under the Burdened Land:
- the soil or matter becomes the property of the Constructing Authority; and
 - the Constructing Authority has no obligation to compensate the Registered Owner; and
 - the Constructing Authority must either stockpile the soil or matter as permitted by paragraph 3.1(h) or remove it from the Burdened Land at the Constructing Authority's own expense.
- 3.3 The Constructing Authority does not need to exercise its rights and powers under this easement personally. It may authorise other people to exercise those rights and powers.
- 3.4 In exercising its rights and powers under this easement, the Constructing Authority must:
- ensure that any work it does on the Burdened Land is done properly; and
 - use reasonable endeavours to cause as little inconvenience as is reasonably practicable to the Registered Owner; and
 - restore the Burdened Land as nearly as is reasonably practicable to its former condition if the Burdened Land is damaged by the Constructing Authority (other than in a manner authorised by this easement).
- 3.5 If the Constructing Authority permanently removes any Infrastructure that had been installed on, in or under the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority under this easement, the Constructing Authority must restore the Burdened Land as nearly as is reasonably practicable to its former condition before the installation of the infrastructure.
- 3.6 If the Registered Owner breaches this easement, the Constructing Authority may do anything the Constructing Authority thinks is reasonably necessary to correct the breach (such as removing a structure erected on the Burdened Land in breach of this easement).
- 4. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF REGISTERED OWNER**
- 4.1 The Registered Owner must:
- not erect any building, structure, pipeline, road, fence, driveway or paving on the Burdened Land without the consent of the Constructing Authority; and
 - not change or allow to fall into disrepair any building, structure, pipeline, road, fence, driveway or paving on the Burdened Land (other than removing one erected on the Burdened Land in breach of this easement); and
 - not alter the ground level of the Burdened Land or change its topography; and
 - not plant trees on the Burdened Land; and
 - not crop, dig or plough the Burdened Land; and
 - not act unreasonably in ensuring that any Infrastructure installed on the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority from time to time is not damaged; and
 - not trespass on any Infrastructure installed on the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority from time to time; and
 - not cause a nuisance that adversely affects the Constructing Authority's rights and powers under this easement or any Infrastructure installed on the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority from time to time, and if any such nuisance arises, not delay in abating any such nuisance; and
 - use the Registered Owner's best endeavours to prevent anyone else doing any of the things that the Registered Owner is required not to do under this easement and not allow anyone else to do any of those things.
- 4.2 The Registered Owner is taken to have the consent of the Constructing Authority to do a thing that would otherwise be in breach of paragraph 4.1(a) or 4.1(b) if:
- a development approval which is current under the *Planning Act 2016* and which attaches to the Burdened Land authorises the Registered Owner to do that thing; and
 - the development approval was given by the Constructing Authority as assessment manager under the *Planning Act 2016*; and
 - the Registered Owner does that thing in accordance with the development approval.
- 4.3 The Registered Owner is responsible for the acts and omissions of anyone claiming through the Registered Owner (like tenants, licensees and mortgagees). An act or omission of any of those people is treated for the purposes of this

- easement as if it was an act or omission of the Registered Owner personally.
- 4.4 The Registered Owner and the Constructing Authority acknowledge and agree that the following covenant conditions the performance of any covenant made by the Constructing Authority:
- (a) The Registered Owner must indemnify and release the Constructing Authority from any claim, action, loss, expense, proceeding or liability by the Registered Owner or anyone else arising from:
 - i. the use or occupation of the Burdened Land; or
 - ii. any act or omission of any person on or affecting the Burdened Land or in any way relating to the Burdened Land or the Infrastructure on it from time to time; or
 - iii. a breach by the Registered Owner of this easement; or
 - iv. the Registered Owner's negligence, except to the extent that the claim, action, loss, expense, proceeding or liability is a direct result of:
 - a. a breach by the Constructing Authority of this easement; or
 - b. the Constructing Authority's negligence.
- 4.5 The operation of section 85B(2) of the *Land Title Act 1994* (Qld) in respect of this easement is expressly excluded. The Constructing Authority is under no liability, under section 85B(2) of the *Land Title Act 1994* or otherwise, to contribute towards the cost of keeping the Burdened Land in a condition appropriate for enjoyment of this easement.
- 4.6 The Registered Owner must obtain the Constructing Authority's written approval before commencing any works on the Burdened Land and the Registered Owner is responsible for all damages and compensations if works are carried out on the Burdened Land without the Constructing Authority's written approval and/or not in accordance with the Constructing Authority's written approval.
- 5. OTHER MATTERS**
- 5.1 All Infrastructure and other things brought onto or installed on the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority from time to time will, as between the Registered Owner and the Constructing Authority, remain the property of the Constructing Authority.
- 5.2 If the Constructing Authority pulls down or breaks open any fencing under this easement:
- (a) the Constructing Authority may either repair the fencing it has pulled down or broken open or install a gate in place of that fencing to at least a standard reasonably equivalent to that of the fencing before it was pulled down or broken open;
 - (b) the owner of the fencing that was pulled down or broken open will become the owner of the repaired fencing or gate; and
 - (c) that owner must maintain the repaired fencing or gate.
- 5.3 The Registered Owner must do all things reasonably required by the Constructing Authority from time to time in order to make sure that the Constructing Authority is given all the rights and powers intended to be conferred by this easement.
