

QUEENSLAND CORRECTIVE SERVICES INSTRUMENT OF SUBDELEGATION

This instrument subdelegates to persons set out in the below table the powers vested in the Minister for Corrective Services and delegated to the Commissioner, Queensland Corrective Services under the *Constitution of Queensland 2001*.

Under section 55(1) of the Constitution of Queensland 2001 a Minister may delegate a power of the State to an appropriately qualified officer of the State. By an Instrument of Delegation dated 17 September 2018, the Minister for Corrective Services delegated to the Commissioner, Queensland Corrective Services the power and legal capacity to enter into an agreement with other persons for the temporary use of land allocated to Queensland Corrective Services.

Under section 55(2) of the Constitution of Queensland 2001 an officer of the State may subdelegate the delegated power to an appropriately qualified officer of the State.

I, Paul Stewart APM, Acting Commissioner, Queensland Corrective Services, subdelegate the delegated power and legal capacity to enter into an agreement with other persons for the temporary use of land allocated to Queensland Corrective Services specified in column 1, to the officers listed in column 2, subject to the relevant limitations and conditions listed in column 3.
