

**QUEENSLAND CORRECTIVE SERVICES  
INSTRUMENT OF DELEGATION OF MINISTER'S POWERS**

This instrument delegates to persons set out in the attached schedules the powers vested in the Minister for Corrective Services under the:

*Constitution of Queensland 2001*

*Parole Orders (Transfer) Act 1984*

Under section 55(1) of the *Constitution of Queensland 2001* a Minister may delegate a power of the State to an appropriately qualified officer of the State.

Under section 12 of the *Parole Orders (Transfer) Act 1984* a Minister may delegate the Minister's powers under the Act to a corrective services officer under the *Corrective Services Act 2006*.

I, Mark Ryan MP, Minister for Police and Minister for Corrective Services delegate the powers listed in column 1 of Schedules 1 and 2 of this Instrument of Delegation to the officer or officers listed in column 2, subject to relevant limitations and conditions listed in column 3.

This document revokes all former instruments of delegations in relation to the same powers or functions which are covered by this Instrument of Delegation.
