At its meeting on Tuesday 11 February 2020, Brisbane City Council adopted amendments to *Brisbane City Plan 2014* to stop townhouses and apartments from being built in areas for single-homes (Major amendment package H). The amendments apply city-wide and will commence on **1 May 2020**.

**Purpose and General Effect**

The amendments are intended to:

- remove provisions in zone codes, development codes and neighbourhood plans supporting Multiple dwellings (townhouses and apartments) in the Low density residential zone, and
- amend other relevant provisions in City Plan to align with this change, including amendments to the Strategic framework, and make necessary consequential amendments.
