Acquisition of Land Act 1967 TAKING OF EASEMENT NOTICE BY THE MINISTER (No 02) 2022

Short title

1.

1. This notice may be cited as the *Taking of Easement Notice* by the Minister (No 02) 2022.

Easement taken [ss.6 and 9(7) of the Act]

2. The easement described in Schedule 2 is taken by Redland City Council for drainage purposes and vests in Redland City Council on and from 29 April 2022.

Rights and obligations

3. That the rights and obligations conferred and imposed by the easement include the matters set out in Schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1

TAKING OF THE EASEMENT

Redland City Council (the "Council") takes the full and free right and liberty of using the easement for drainage purposes and to exercise all powers, authorities and discretions vested in it by law for the passage or conveyance of rainwater through or over the easement.

2. COUNCIL'S RIGHTS

- 2.1 The Owner must not act, or omit from acting, in any manner that impedes the passage or conveyance of rainwater through or over the easement.
- 2.2. The Council shall have the full and free right and liberty at all times hereafter to enter upon the easement for the purposes of carrying out and constructing the Works within the easement and thereafter to remove any obstructions to the Works and to forever use and maintain such Works as it shall from time to time think fit and in so doing, the Council by its employees, agents and Council's Authorised Users shall have the right to:-
 - (a) inspect, maintain and repair, clear, and remove obstructions from the surface of the easement;
 - (b) construct, install, extend, deepen, widen, cleanse, add to, remove, inspect, maintain and repair the Works and when and where thought fit by the Council to remove and replace the Works with new works (whether of a similar nature to those replaced or not);
 - (c) dig into the easement, and to open and break up the soil of the easement or any part thereof including the sub-

surface thereof;

- (d) remove and dispose of spoil created as a consequence of the Council exercising its rights hereunder;
- (e) clear the easement including cutting and removing timber, trees and undergrowth from the easement;
- (f) enter upon and remain, pass and repass on and over the Easement for all or any of the purposes aforesaid, with or without vehicles, plant and equipment of any description whatsoever; and
- (g) do such other Works and things through, across, in or under the easement as are incidental to the proper exercise of the rights granted to the Council hereunder.

3. OWNER'S OBLIGATIONS

- 3.1 The Owner shall not at any time without the express written permission of the Council:
 - (a) erect any buildings or structures including fences upon the easement or any part thereof or otherwise permit the easement or any part thereof to be used in such a way as to obstruct the passage or conveyance of rainwater through or over the easement or interfere with the associated rights granted hereunder over the easement or interfere with Council's exercise of its rights granted by these covenants;
 - (b) install landscaping, plant trees, shrubs or other vegetation of any description that obstructs the passage or conveyance of rainwater through or over the easement or interferes with Council's exercise of its rights granted by these covenants;
 - (c) remove or stockpile or permit the removal or stockpiling of any soil, sand, gravel, or other substance or material on the easement or construct any earthworks on the easement which would in any way obstruct the passage or conveyance of rainwater through or over the easement or interfere with the Council's exercise of its rights granted by these covenants.

4. INCONVENIENCE TO OWNER

- 4.1 The Council shall in its sole discretion determine how and in what manner the rights acquired by the Council hereunder are exercised.
- 4.2 The Council is not in any event responsible for any inconvenience or disturbance to the Owner or occupiers of the Owner's Land arising out of the course of or by virtue

of the exercise by the Council of its rights hereunder.

5. **REMOVAL OF UNAUTHORISED STRUCTURES ETC.**

- 5.1 If a building structure or other material or thing is erected, placed, found or installed upon the easement in contravention of Clause 3, the Council or the Council's Employees may, in addition to any other remedies and after having first given the Owner reasonable notice of its intention to invoke this clause, enter upon the easement and remove or demolish the relevant matter and, if it does so:
 - (a) it may dispose of the relevant matter or any resultant demolition materials in such manner as it sees fit without being liable to account to the Owner (except as provided in clause 5.1(b)); and
 - (b) it may recover, in any Court of competent jurisdiction, costs actually incurred by it in taking that action (including internal wage and administration costs) less any monies actually received by it as a result of disposing of the relevant matter or any resultant demolition materials.

6. **PROPERTY IN WORKS**

6.1 The Works remain the property of the Council despite being fixed to the easement which is not inconsistent with the Council's rights under this these covenants.

7. RELEASE AND INDEMNITY

- 7.1. The Council indemnifies and agrees to keep indemnified the Owner against all actions, suits, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, losses, damages and expenses (Claim) arising out of or in any way connected to or resulting from the granting of this easement to the Council or which is connected to or resulting from the Council's use and occupation of the easement (all of which are referred to as "the indemnified acts or omissions") save to the extent that the Claim arises as a result of any negligent act or omission of the Owner.
- 7.2. The Council hereby releases and discharges the Owner from any Claim relating to the indemnified acts or omissions which may be made against the Owner, save to the extent that the Claim arises as a result of any negligent act or omission of the Owner.
- 7.3. To remove doubt, the Council specifically agrees that the indemnity provided by the Council in Clause 7.1 extends to any Claim (as defined by Clause 7) arising from the use of any other area of the Owner's Land by the Council.

8. PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

- 8.1. The Council must effect a public liability insurance policy with an insurer authorised under the *Insurance Act 1973* (Commonwealth) or, in any other case, naming the Council as the insured covering legal liability for any loss of or damage to any property and for the injury (including death) to any person arising out of anything done or omitted on or about the easement or any improvements thereon and against all claims, demands, proceedings, costs, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect thereof subject to the terms and conditions of the insurance policy.
- 8.2. Such policy must:
 - (a) be for an amount of not less than twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000.00) in respect of all claims arising out of a single event; and
 - (b) be effected on a "claims occurring" basis so that any claim made by the Council under the policy after the expiration of the period of policy cover but relating to an event occurring during the currency of the policy will be covered by the policy subject to the claim meeting the policy's other terms and conditions; and
 - (c) be maintained at all times during the currency of this easement, and upon receipt of any notice of cancellation, the Council must immediately effect another public liability insurance policy in accordance with the terms

and conditions of this easement.

- 8.3. The Council must forward a certificate of currency to the Owner within 10 business days of a request by the Owner who may only make such a request once a year.
- 8.4. The Council must, as soon as practicable, inform the Owner, in writing, of the occurrence of any event that the Council considers is likely to give rise to a claim under the policy of insurance effected and must ensure that the Owner are kept fully informed of subsequent actions and developments concerning the claim.
- 8.5. To remove doubt, the requirements of Clause 8 apply to any other area of the Owner's Land used by the Council.

9. COSTS

The costs and outlays of and incidental to the preparation, completion, stamping and registration of this easement shall be borne and paid by the Council.

10. COUNCIL MAY USE LAND

The Owner hereby gives express permission (which permission is hereby declared to be irrevocable) to the Council and the Council's Employees and if necessary with vehicles, machinery and equipment of any description whatsoever and whether laden or unladen to come onto and use the Owner's Land as may be occasionally required by the Council in the exercise of or incidental to its rights contained in this easement and in this regard the Owner hereby confers on the Council and the Council 's Employees all of the rights, powers and liberties mentioned in clauses 2 and 5 of this easement, so long as such rights, powers and liberties are not exercised or utilised on a permanent or prolonged basis.

11. GOVERNING LAW

The laws of Queensland govern this easement.

12. SEVERANCE

If at any time a provision of this easement is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable in any respect, that will not affect or impair the legality, validity or enforceability of any other provision of this easement.

13. CONSTRUCTION AND INTERPRETATION

13.1 DEFINITIONS

(1) **"Council"** means the Redland City Council and its successors and assigns;

(2) **"Council's Employees"** means the Council's employees, agents, contractors and other persons authorised by the Council;

- (3) "Owner" means the Owner and includes;
 - (a) the executors, administrators and assigns of the Owner and each of them;
 - (b) the registered owner for the time being of the Owner's Land.

(4) **"Owner's Land"** means Lot 3 on RP68430 in Title Reference 17527227.

- (5) "Work" means:
- (a) work required to maintain the surface of the easement so that no impediment exists to the passage or conveyance of rainwater through or over the easement including, without limitation, mowing the grass and keeping the surface free of trees, shrubs, weeds and undergrowth, preventing the stockpiling of soil, green waste or other substances of any description upon the surface and keeping the surface clean and free of debris or other obstructions of any type whatsoever.
- (b) underground pipes including, but not limited to pressure pipelines or such other pipes, structures or facilities considered by the Council, acting reasonably, from time to time as necessary or expedient for the passage or conveyance of water under the surface of the easement

together with all other usual or necessary fittings and attachments, whether above or below the surface of the easement including but not limited to valves, water boosters, meters and connections, as well as works for the protection and/or support of all such things.

11.2 CONSTRUCTION

In this grant of Easement:

- (a) Headings are for convenience only and do not affect interpretation; and unless the context indicates a contrary intention;
- (b) An obligation or a liability assumed by, or a right conferred on, 2 or more persons binds or benefits them jointly and severally;
- (c) "Person" includes an individual, the estate of an individual, a corporation, an authority, an association or a joint venture (whether incorporated or unincorporated), a partnership and a trust;
- (d) A reference to a party includes that party's executors, administrators, successors and permitted assigns, including persons taking by way of novation;
- (e) A word imported the singular includes the plural (and vice versa), and a word indicating a gender includes every other gender;
- (f) If a word or phrase is given a defined meaning, any other part of speech of grammatical form of that word or phrase has a corresponding meaning; and
- (g) "Includes" in any form is not a word of limitation.
