Prescribed fee

- Please note fees are charged per register (for part or all of the register).

- Fees are prescribed under Schedule 10 of the *Biosecurity Regulation 2016* and are reviewed annually in line with the Consumer Pricing Index (CPI). Fees are subject to change.

R1 – Biosecurity Register	The Biosecurity Register contains information that relates to registered biosecurity entities; restricted places; restricted animals; and restricted biosecurity matter. R2 – Register of Biosecurity Orders	The register of biosecurity orders contains information about current orders on a place including the biosecurity matter and the actions required to minimise the biosecurity risk.	Buying a property and needing information about biosecurity risks present.
