Business Growth Fund

Helping businesses purchase and implement highly specialised equipment or services through co-contribution grants up to \$50,000.

Small Business Digital Grants Program

Enabling small businesses to access the latest digital technologies through matched grant funding up to \$10,000.

Small Business Entrepreneur Grants Program

Helping newly started businesses to access professional advice and support with up to \$5,000 in matched funding.

Queensland Small Business Week

Celebrates the commitment, efforts and passion of small business owners and includes a program of activities focused on making Queensland the place for small business to start, grow and employ. In 2018, Queensland Small Business Week will be held from 28 May to 1 June.

100 Faces of Small Business

Showcases the human stories behind Queensland's diverse small businesses. These stories are presented as a digital gallery on the Business Queensland website.

Advancing Women in Business

This initiative recognises the valuable contribution women in business make to Queensland's economy by providing supporting programs and encouraging more women to start and grow their own business.
