Area: Gladstone pilotage area

Locality: South Trees Inlet

Activity: geotechnical testing

Mariners are advised that:

Geotechnical testing will be taking place in South Trees Inlet from Monday, 22 April 2024, until Thursday, 15 May 2024. The testing will be conducted at two locations.

Location 1: latitude 23° 57.0228' S, longitude 151° 19.1547' E

Location 2: latitude 23° 56.9131' S, longitude 151° 19.5985' E

The jack up barge 'Minnie' will be moved from her launch location (latitude 23° 56.3982' S, longitude 151° 18.1609' E) to the test locations by support vessel 'The Punt'.

When jacked up, 'Minnie' will display relevant flags and day shapes. At night 'Minnie' will be jacked up above the high tide level and be fitted with orange corner lights on each leg and an all-round white light at the centre of the vessel.

Mariners are requested to obey displayed flags and to navigate the area with caution.
