Buoy 7 - latitude 23°47.072'S longitude 151°11.133'E

Buoys are 1.2m in diameter, circular in shape with a yellow hood affixed on top. The buoys will be lit by a yellow light flashing once every 4.5 seconds (FI Y 4.5s).
